Land Development Update North American Development Group

(NADG) purchased land for new home

development in the Ken-Caryl Ranch Plains. This land is privately owned and was not owned by the Master Association. A total of approximately 700 units (singlefamily, townhomes, and multi-family) are proposed over the three parcels of land. The land is currently zoned for residential use and includes the following locations:

* East of C-470 and north of Ken Caryl Ave. (Parcel A and C) * Southwest corner of Ken Caryl Ave. and Chatfield Ave (Parcel B)

NADG updated the draft conceptual site plan for one of the land parcels, called Parcel A, that is located east of C-470 and north of Ken Caryl Ave.






