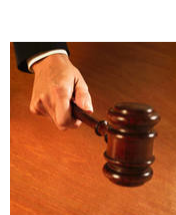


### Architectural Committee to Discuss Commercial Vehicle Rule

The Ken-Caryl Ranch Master Association Architectural Committee will meet Thursday, Feb. 13 at 7:30 a.m. at the Ranch House to discuss and vote on a new commercial rule for the community, that states, in part, that all commercial vehicles "...shall be well maintained and kept at all times in an enclosed garage, in the driveway, or at an off-site facility...Only one such vehicle permitted per property."
