

questions for the candidates to answer and return. That

supplemental information will be distributed to interested candidates and will then be due by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, June 16. The Board will discuss the candidates and the vacancy will be filled by appointment by majority vote of the remaining Board members at the June 22 Board meeting, or a subsequent Board meeting, if schedule dictates. The appointee will serve until the next regular Board election on May 3, 2022 at which time the vacancy will be filled by election for the remaining unexpired portion of the original


term which is until the May 2, 2023 election.


