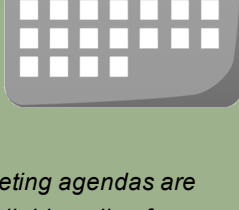

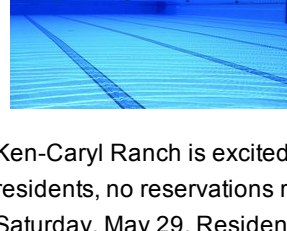

Calling all Residents! Open MD Board Seat



The Ken-Caryl Ranch Metropolitan District expects a Board member vacancy in late May. The Board has determined it will follow historical practice for filling the vacancy; therefore, letters of interest and qualifications will be accepted from eligible candidates until 5 p.m. on Wednesday, May 19. All eligible candidates must own property or reside in District boundaries and must be a registered voter in the State of Colorado.

The Board will review the submitted letters of interest at the May 25 Board meeting and discuss a list of supplemental questions for the candidates to answer and return. That supplemental information will be distributed to interested candidates and will then be due by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, June 16. The Board will discuss the candidates and the vacancy will be filled by appointment by majority vote of the remaining Board members at the June 22 Board meeting, or a subsequent Board meeting, if schedule dictates.

The appointee will serve until the next regular Board election on May 3, 2022 at which time the vacancy will be filled by election for the remaining unexpired portion of the original term which is until the May 2, 2023 election.
