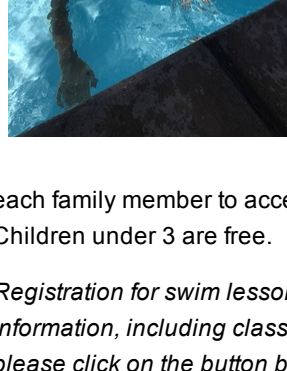

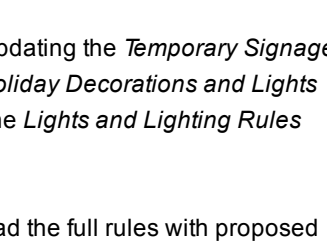

Changes to Covenant Rules Reminder

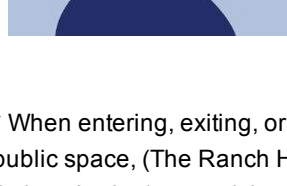

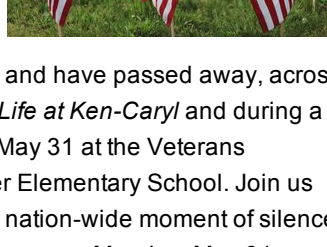
Jefferson County Public Health Revised Mask Order

The Jefferson County Public Health Revised Mask Order requires masks in the following situations:

- * When entering, exiting, or moving around in any indoor public space, (The Ranch House, The Community Center and Dakota Lodge), a mask is required.
- * Groups of nine or less in an indoor space are not required to wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status.
- * Groups of 10 or more in an indoor space must wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status.
- * Childcare and Preschool programs/spaces require masks regardless of group size or vaccination status.

The order is in effect as of May 5, 2021 and is set to expire or be updated on June 6, 2021.

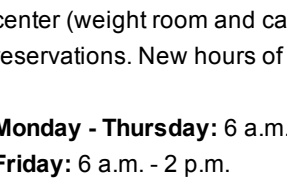
Ken-Caryl Ranch Memorial Day Tribute

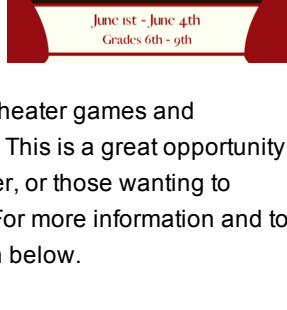
Great news! Jefferson County center (weight room and cardio area) will no longer require reservations. New hours of operation are:

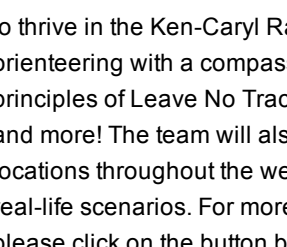
Register for Ken-Caryl Theater Club!

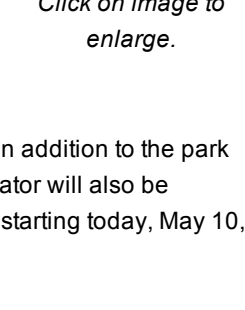
Register for Backcountry Skills Camp

Noxious Weed Treatment Begins



Springtime has arrived in the Valley, bringing longer days and warmer temperatures. With this warmer weather, noxious weeds are starting to pop up in the open spaces, lawns and parks. The park rangers will begin their noxious weed management - including herbicide spraying, hand removal, and mowing in our open space this week. They will continue to spray noxious

weeds through June and into July. In addition to the park rangers, a contract herbicide applicator will also be conducting work in the open space starting today, May 10, and will continue into the summer.

We are required by Colorado law to manage certain noxious weeds in our open space areas. To manage them, we take an integrative approach that uses multiple methods to combat noxious weed spread.
