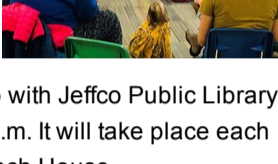
Last Call! Ken-Caryl Ranch Memorial Day Tribute

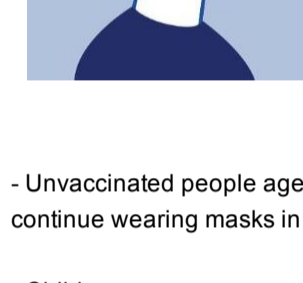

Current Mask Orders

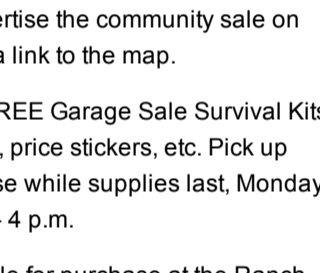
Jefferson County Public Health is following the more relaxed mask requirements from the State of Colorado:

Community Garage Sale on June 4 & 5



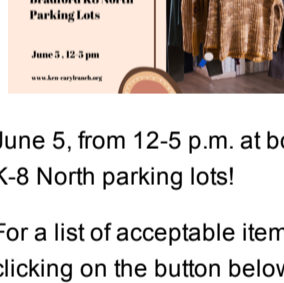

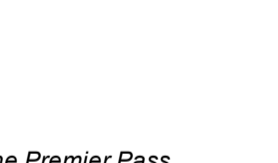
New this year! Got items that didn't sell at your garage sale? Then be sure to bring them to the Goodwill Drop-off on Saturday,

KC Fitness Offers Water Classes All Week This Summer!



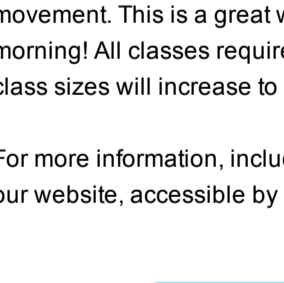
Exciting news! KC Fitness will offer water classes every day of the week this summer! Classes will be held at the Community Center pool during the main pool season. Class times are:

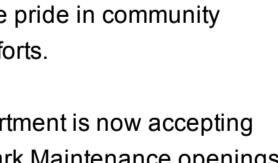
KC Fitness Introduces Vinyasa Yoga!

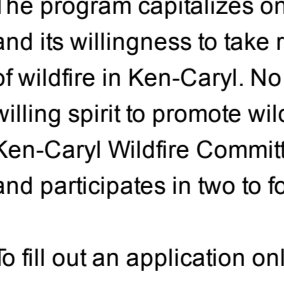


Enjoy the great outdoors and make Ken-Caryl Ranch beautiful! We are looking for dedicated team members who take pride in community beautification and maintenance efforts.
