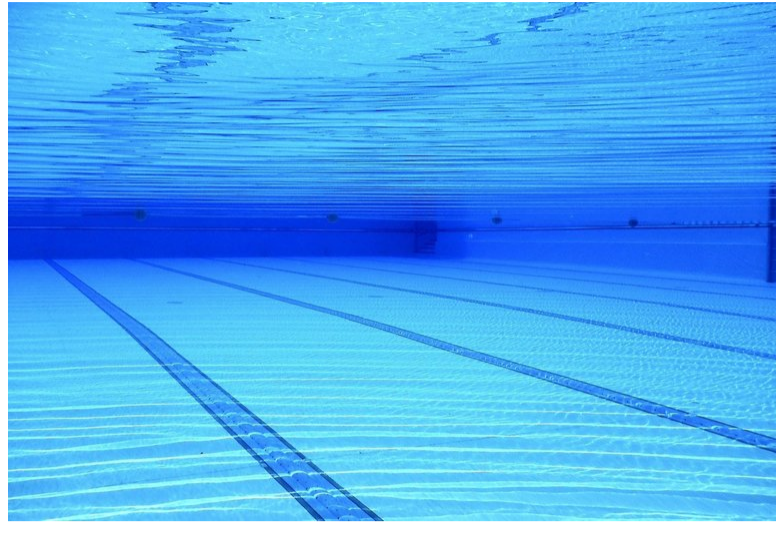

## Pool Cues: Reservation Information and Updates

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate state and county rules and regulations regarding COVID-19 prevention efforts. At this time, Jefferson County has rescinded its current Mask Order. Individuals are now are subject to the state-wide Mask Order issued by Governor Jared Polis. ### New Pool Registration Updates

We are still asking that families and individuals only take two time slots per week, once per day, with the following exception: if a 7-9 a.m. time slot is not full the day before you wish to attend, you may sign up. However, reservations are not to exceed a total of four time slots per week.

Please continue to social distance when in line for the diving board, slide and in the pool. Masks do not need to be worn while swimming or in your designated sitting area if you are six feet from those not in your household.

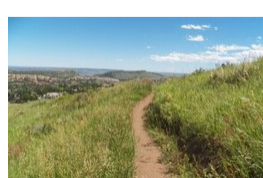
