Pool Cues: Mask Order in Effect

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate state and county rules and regulations regarding COVID-19 prevention efforts.

Per Governor Jared Polis' Mask Order, face coverings are required for wear at the pool at all times except when in the water or in your designated sitting area and 6 feet away from those not in your household. Lifeguards will wear masks when they are not on stand.

Additional COVID-19 social distancing rules and recommendations for pool use include:

- Reduced pool occupancy with six-foot social distancing for those not within your household.
- No deck furniture, pool toys, life jackets, or other shared supplies or equipment available for use; members of the same household may bring shared, facility-approved, equipment for their use only.
- Social distancing cues on the deck and lawn.
- Locker-room use restricted to restrooms; shower prior to coming to the facility.
- No swim lessons, private rentals, or concession sales.

Doggie Dip Day!

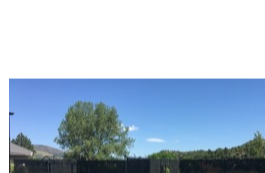

Need to sit this match out? No problem! You can now conveniently cancel your court reservations online!

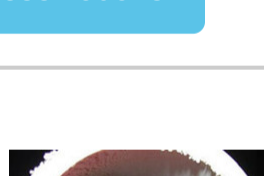
On the flip side, you can also reserve your tennis courts online up to three days in advance!

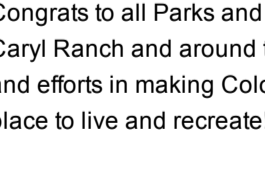

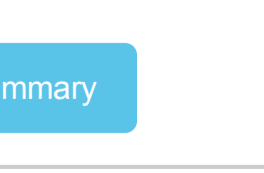
