This time of year, bears are on the hunt to pack on 20,000 calories a day. A fed bear is a dead bear, so let's protect these bruins. Here's how: 1.) Secure all trash and don't put trash out the evening prior to

and pick up/discard fallen fruit from trees.

2.) Remove ALL attractants, including bird feeders, dog food

3.) Secure car doors and remove anything that emits a scent including food, wrappers, bags, even scented wipes. 4.) Close all garage doors, especially at night. 5.) If you see a bear in your yard, haze it. Activate the car alarm, honk your horn, yell from a window, use an airhorn,

maintain a safe distance from area wildlife, including bears.
