## Food Drive for Fitness at the Community Center

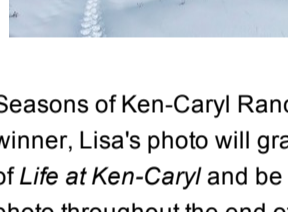

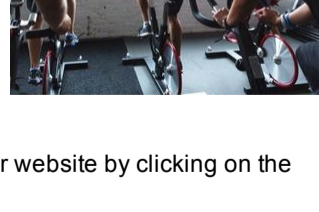

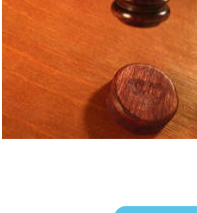
