Resident Street Plowing and Sanding

Snow is expected this week! Residents are reminded that plowing and sanding operations for Ken-Caryl Ranch fall under Jefferson County Road and Bridge Division, which takes place in four phases during a storm. The order in which streets are plowed in each phase is based on the following definitions of priority:

Priority 1 - Main arterial streets that provide for high traffic volumes.

Priority 2 - Major subdivision collectors, school zones and school bus routes.

Priority 3 - Residential or other local roads that carry moderate to low traffic volumes.

Priority 4 - Cul-de-sacs or other dead-end roads carrying very low traffic volumes.
