Classifications of e-Bikes Allowed in Open Space



Class 1 e-bikes are now allowed on natural surface and paved open space, greenbelt, and park trails. Class 2 e-bikes are **only** allowed on paved open space, greenbelt, and park trails.

Classification of e-Bikes
CLASS 1: An electric bicycle that only provides assistance when the rider is pedaling; the motor ceases at 20 miles per hour (mph).
CLASS 2: An electric bicycle that provides assistance regardless of whether the rider is pedaling; the motor ceases at 20 mph.

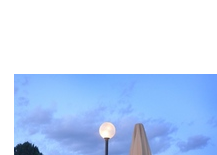

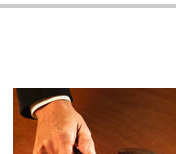


Challenger British Soccer Camp

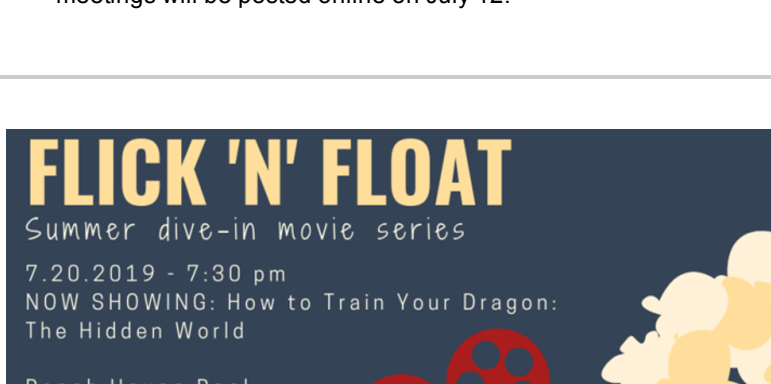

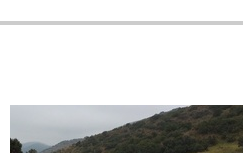
Next Joint Study Session Scheduled for July 16
