## Potential New Home Development

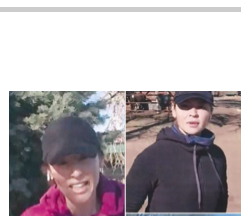

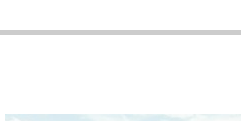

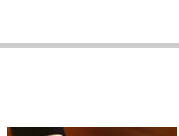
