- Delayed Trash Days: Waste Connections observes the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day, unless they fall on a weekend day. If your normal pick-up day falls on a holiday or after a holiday, your collection schedule will run one day late that
- Recycling Notes: Please remember to have your trash and recycling curbside by 7 a.m. on your collection day. Trash and recycling should be placed four feet apart from each other at the curb. Waste Connections will pick up individual bags or service toters/cans which homeowners have individually purchased. Recycling containers need to be clearly marked as recycling. Waste Connections has provided recycling stickers which can be placed on any purchased container. If you need a sticker please visit the Ranch House or Community Center. Single Stream Recycling means that glass, plastic, tin, and aluminum and paper products may all be placed in the same container.

# Kanger Field Notes

### **Camping In Open Space**

Rangers receive several questions a year from residents interested in camping in Open Space but are not familiar with the campsites, locations or how to reserve them.

There are officially only seven areas to camp. Two areas are reserved only through

the Ranch House: the Bradford Open Space as it is the only site that has a fire pit and the Dakota Lodge. The other five sites can be reserved at the first come, first served selfservice station on the porch of the Dakota

Campers will first check the registration sheet at Dakota Lodge to see if a site is open. If it is, they will list the site and sign their name. Campers will then pick up a camping permit at the self-service station at Dakota Lodge and a camping brochure with all of the campsite descriptions and camping rules. Once at the site, the permit will be placed on the hook of the campsite marker.

Camping is limited to three days and two nights at each site. Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. No fires of any kind (except at the Bradford Open Space) are allowed; only liquid-fuel stoves. All trash must be packed out and trees/plants may not be used to support clothes lines, tents or any other camping gear.

#### **Campsite Descriptions**

- 1. Bradford Open Space: Mowed area behind the restored ruins of the Bradford Perley House, which was built in 1859. Sits within mixed grasslands and backs to a historic apple orchard. Dramatic red rock formations dominate the landscape.
- 2. Dakota Lodge: Irrigated turf behind Dakota Lodge. In-stream pond, picnic area, playground and volleyball court accompany the site.
- Gothic Overlook: Clearings A or B near the east end of Gothic Overlook Trail. The site is dominated by Gambel oak and mountain mahogany shrubs with great views of the Valley and all the way into Denver.
- Manor House: Clearings A or B south of the picnic shelter, or site C in front of the old corral in the meadow south of Little John's Chimney Trail. Near the top of Manor House Trail, this site is tucked between oaks and ponderosa pine on the edge of a meadow that fills with wildflowers in spring. Campers can view Mt. Evans to the northwest on clear days.
- 5. **North Hogback:** East side of North Hogback Trail, 50 feet north of the picnic shelter. This campsite lies between the Dakota and Lyons Hogbacks in a valley with mixed grasses and occasional narrow-leaf yucca clusters.
- 6. Silver Cliff: Clearing 50 feet south of Bradford Trail. One of the park's more secluded offerings. With a covering of oak and mature ponderosa pine, campers have a southeasterly facing view of the foothills and Pike National Forest beyond.
- Tin Cup: Clearing north of Bradford Trail, marked by a sign. The park's highest campsite may take its name from a community on Colorado's Western Slope. At more than 7,800 feet above sea level, Tin Cup affords spectacular views of the Open Space system.

To receive a bracelet, you will need to provide one of the following items to prove residency:

- 1. Valid CO Driver's License with current KCR address.
- 2. Valid CO ID with current KCR address.
- 3. Valid property tax statement with the applicant's name for the current KCR address.
- Valid warranty deed with the applicant's name for the current KCR address.

The ID bracelet can be placed in the following locations:

**On a Bike:** Handlebars or stem of bike; no other place is acceptable.

**On a Hiker:** Wrist, jacket zipper, dog leash handle or ankle.

Remember, the Rangers and Volunteer Patrollers may only have a second to recognize the bracelet as you come upon them on the trail. If they cannot see it, then you will have to stop to prove residency. Please remember to keep the bracelet as visible as possible! # 1 July 31, 2013 Life at Kew-Caryle Trash And Recycling **Services Information**

The Ranch House often gets asked questions about trash service, so we've put together this information to help answer the most frequently asked questions. Basic trash and recycling information is always listed on Page 2 of the paper.

Ken-Caryl Ranch has a contract with Waste Connections for our curbside trash and recycling program. Each neighborhood has a designated day of pickup. This service is included in your Master Association membership dues.

Along with a variety of services that Waste Connections offers to residents, just one trash removal vehicle and one recycling collection vehicle will be in your neighborhood just one day of the week. Please have trash and recycling out at the curb and placed on opposite sides of the driveway by 7 a.m. Waste Connections may be contacted at 303-288-2100 or www.wcdenver.com.

#### **Trash Service**

Weekly curbside household trash collection consists of customer-owned containers (not to exceed 96 gallons). Waste Connections will pick up trash materials not to exceed 10 bags of regular household trash and six bags/bundles of yard waste. Branches must be less than four feet in length, no great-

er than one foot in diameter, less than 40 pounds and tied for easy removal. Waste Connections can take many large items, but there is a fee associated with this service depending on the type and amount of the items. Please call at least 48 hours in advance to schedule and pay for your pickup.

#### **Recycling Service**

The Waste Connections recycling service is single-stream, meaning recyclable materials can be mixed together in one bin. Waste Connections observes the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July Fourth, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day (unless the holiday falls on a weekend day, in which case the regular schedule is followed). During these holiday weeks, trash removal will be delayed one day if your scheduled pickup falls on or after the holiday (i.e. if a holiday falls on a Wednesday, trash removal will be delayed one day for everyone scheduled on Wednesday and Thursday.)

Life at Ken-Caryl

More than 120 people attended the informative *Prehistoric Archaeology of Ken-Caryl Ranch* presentation by Jack Warner on Thursday, July 11 at the Ranch House. It was hosted by the Ken-Caryl Ranch Historical Society and brought the total number of people who have attended the presentation to almost 250. It was first given in December, and this repeat presentation was offered because the first was so popular.



Ken-Caryl Ranch resident Jack Warner, who is the president of the Colorado Archaeological Society, gave a presentation titled **Prehistoric Archaeology of Ken-Caryl Ranch** to more than 120 people on July 11 at the Ranch House.

Jack, a 28-year resident of the Cimarron neighborhood on Ken-Caryl Ranch, provided fascinating and interesting facts about who and what inhabited Ken-Caryl Ranch in prehistoric times up to 8,000 years ago. Jack is currently the president of the Denver Chapter of the Colorado Archaeological Society (CAS) and a member of the Center for the Study of First Americans.

The presentation was based on the findings from seven significant archaeological digs that were led by the Colorado Archaeological Society prior to housing development. Some of the topics he covered were ancient Native Americans in the area, CAS excavations, artifacts discovered and major archaeological sites found right here on Ken-Caryl Ranch. A few of the artifacts found during the CAS excavations are exhibited at the west end of the Ranch House in a display provided by the Historical Society. The majority are stored at the University of Denver.

#### Xeriscape Basics

Colorado's Front Range receives an average of less than 15 inches of rain a year, making supplemental watering a necessity for most landscapes. More than half of the water used in homes is applied to landscapes. That's why landscaping for water conservation is so important.

By applying the principles of xeriscape, a landscape can be beautiful and diverse while using less water. Planning a landscape, improving the soil, choosing appropriate plants, and proper watering, mulching, and maintenance all play a role in conserving water.

Plan and design a landscape before investing time and money. When a plan has been perfected, start a xeriscape by improving the soil. Mix organic material into the soil to make it rich and productive. Choose waterconserving types of grass, such as buffalo or blue grama. Mulched areas, decks and paths are alternatives to grass. Mulches cover the soil and minimize evaporation, reduce weeds and slow erosion.

Many beautiful plants that don't require much water are available at local nurseries or garden centers. After selecting plants, plan for their watering needs. Developing a system that meets the different moisture requirements of each plant saves water. Xeriscapes are low maintenance but do require some


