

Just a quick reminder to follow the Ken-Caryl Ranch Political Signage

· Professionally made signs will be allowed on private property only (including property owned by the Master Association, with Board approval) with approval of the

- private property owner no more than 45 days prior to the day of the election and must be removed within one week after the election. Political signs may not be attached to fences. • Political signs on any owner's property are limited to one per office or ballot issue.
- Political signs may not be attached to utility boxes, light poles, traffic signals or trees.


