



Urban Drainage and Flood Control District recently completed the North Tributary to Massey Draw Bank Stabilization Project

at Ken Caryl Ave. near the Equestrian Center. The improvements were designed to repair the existing erosion and minimize future erosion of this section of drainageway. All areas disturbed by construction activities will be reseeded. Urban Drainage will maintain this project for Jefferson County and monitor revegetated areas to assure a good vegetative cover. Urban Drainage was formed to assist local governments in the Denver area with multi-jurisdictional drainage and flood control problems. It is funded through a mill levy as part of your property taxes.






