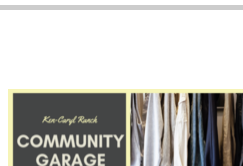

Pickleball Lessons

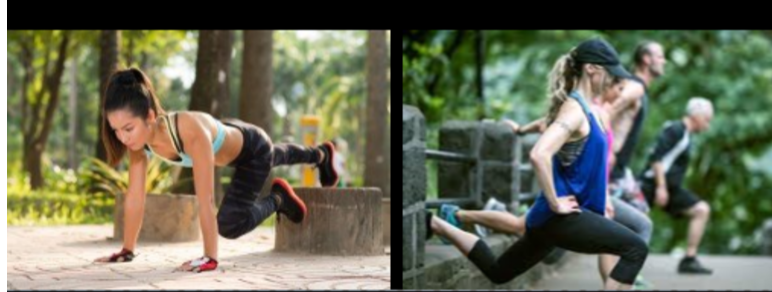
