Fire Restrictions

Sheriff Jeff Shrader implemented temporary Stage 1 Fire Restrictions for all lands in Jefferson County. These restrictions are being enacted due to current dry conditions favorable for the possibility of a wildfire and limited

availability of fire control resources. The use of all fireworks is prohibited within the restricted area. Citizens wishing to obtain current fire restriction or fire ban information, firework regulations, burn permit information, or to report a firework violation can call the Jeffco Sheriff's Fire Information Hotline at 303-271-8200. 
