Construction Update

staff are working with Ohlson Lavoie Architects on a design for the new pool at the Ranch House. To ensure there is sufficient time for public input, a



more thorough design and bid process, and to accumulate more funding, the Boards and staff would like to push the pool build out a year and start in fall 2019 instead of 2018. This would mean the current Ranch House Pool would remain for the 2019 summer swim season. The pool may cost more money than initially thought, especially if the majority of the community's needs and desires are incorporated. Delaying the pool construction by a year will allow more money to be saved. Even after evaluating possible increases in construction costs, the Boards and staff still feel it is in the community's best interest to wait a year. The architect is currently improving the design based on feedback from the community open house in March. A revised design will be presented at another open house later this summer. 




