## Fireworks Prohibited in Ken-Caryl Ranch Open Space/Parks

If you see these signs around KCR, they have been placed by the Master Association in an effort to keep residents and homes safe this 4th of July. Please leave fireworks to the professionals, as they are prohibited in Ken-Caryl open space and parks.



Ken-Caryl residents must adhere to Jeffco's rules and regulations regarding fireworks on their properties. However, we do recommend that residents that border/are in close proximity to open space/parks refrain from setting off fireworks that omit a spark.

## Use of Motorized Vehicles Prohibited in KCR

Just a kindly reminder to please save Zoom(ing) for online use only! Unauthorized vehicles on Ken-Caryl's trails are prohibited, which includes, but is not limited to, motorcycles, motorized scooters, and any other motorized vehicles. Class 1 e-bikes are allowed on natural surface and paved open space, greenbelt, and park trails. Class 2 e-bikes are only allowed on paved open space, greenbelt, and park trails.

Class 3 e-bikes are only allowed on roads and parking lots where motorized vehicles are authorized to travel. However, "Other Power-Driven Mobility Devices" (OPDMD) are allowed on open space, greenbelt, and park trails in accordance with "Guidelines for use of OPDMD on properties owned or leased by KCRMD and KCRMA," which can be found on our website by clicking on the button below.

## Willow Springs Trail Bracelet Requirements



The annual access tag requirements to use the Willow Springs Trails, which are north of Ken-Caryl's private open space, are as follows:

**\* Bracelets are allocated to Trail Club volunteers that must complete and sign an annual Ken-Caryl Ranch volunteer liability waiver.**  
**\* Volunteers must complete 10+ hours of volunteer work on approved open space/trail related work.**

It's important to note that the KCRMA and Willow Springs have agreed to limit the number of tags to 110 per community. Tags are allocated every March based on hours worked for the previous year and the Trail Club has distributed all 110 for this year.
