Please be advised that guests not accompanied by a Ken-Caryl Ranch resident, or who do not

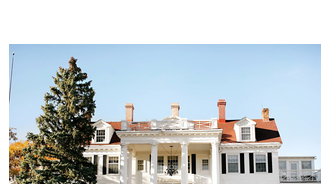

Rangers are required to issue a contact notice for the rule violation and if the person is contacted twice within a 36-month period, the Jefferson County Sheriff is contacted and a citation is issued.

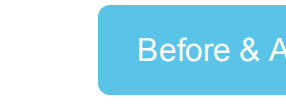
