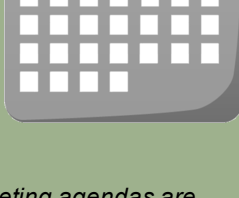

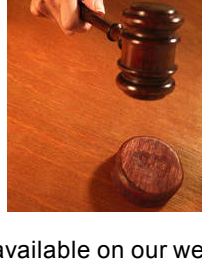

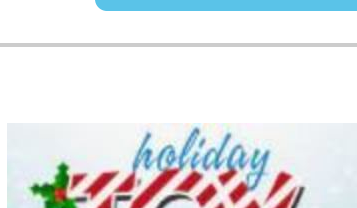
### Master Association Board Voting on Stove Prairie Trail Re-alignment
