Inclusion Agreement Information Session



The Metropolitan District will host a public information session tonight, Jan.10, regarding the Agreement for Inclusion of Property with North American Development Group (NADG), which governs the process for inclusion of the NADG property into Metropolitan District boundaries, and the transfer of the park and recreation facilities that NADG is building to the Metropolitan District. This agreement was approved by the Metropolitan District Board on Oct. 26, 2021 and by NADG on Nov. 4, 2021, and is currently in the process of implementation. Information regarding the Agreement for Inclusion of Property will be reviewed by District staff and legal counsel, and the community will have the opportunity to ask questions regarding the agreement and its implementation. A copy of the agreement, along with information on how to access the meeting via Zoom, can be found on our website, accessible by clicking on the button below. This public information session will be held at the Ranch House and online from 6-8 p.m.

Please note: The purpose of this meeting is to address questions regarding the approved Inclusion Agreement. There will be a future meeting with NADG to discuss the parks and recreation specifications.
