



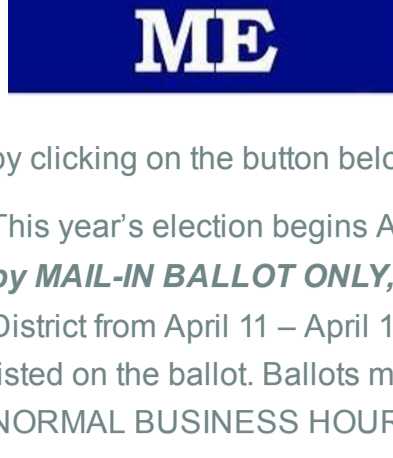

2022 MD Board Election

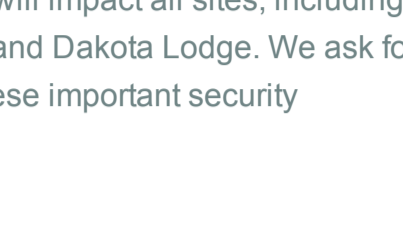
This year, 10 residents have thrown their hat into the ring for four open seats on the MD Board; two seats for a one-year term and two for a three-year term. Candidate profiles are currently available on our website, accessible by clicking on the button below.

This year's election begins April 13 and closes May 3 at 7 p.m. **Voting in this election is by MAIL-IN BALLOT ONLY, not online.** Ballots will be mailed to eligible electors of the District from April 11 – April 18. Ballots may be dropped off or mailed to the locations listed on the ballot. Ballots may be dropped off INSIDE the Ranch House DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS, Monday - Thursday from 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. It is up to the elector to ensure their ballot is received by 7 p.m. on Election Day. 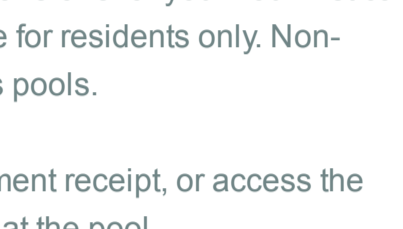


Easter Egg Event Coming to the Ranch House

Pool Passes and Fobs



Purchase your pool pass today! If you already have a key fob (tag) your membership will be automatically loaded to your key fob. Scan your key fob at the pool entrance for access. If you don't have a key fob and would like one, stop by the Community Center or the Ranch House during normal business hours and our Guest Services staff will make one for you. Your first card is free, replacements are \$1. Key fobs and pool passes are for residents only. Non-residents may purchase day passes to access Ken-Caryl's pools.

Don't like key fobs? Screenshot the bar code on your payment receipt, or access the original receipt in your account and scan from your device at the pool.

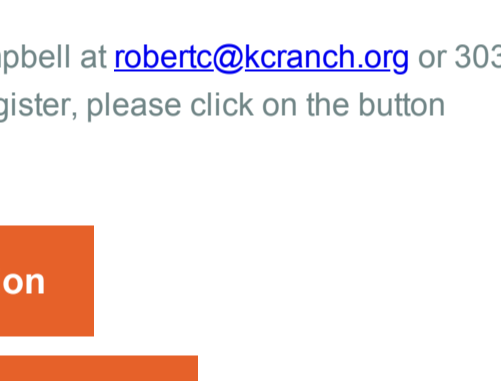
Want to Get Involved? Consider Applying for the Open Space Committee!

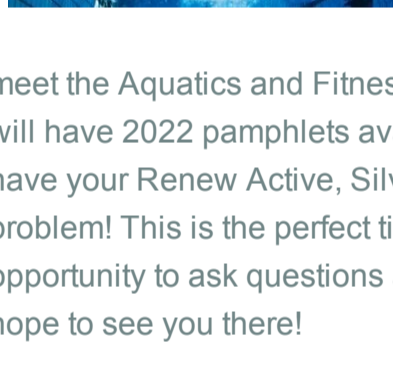

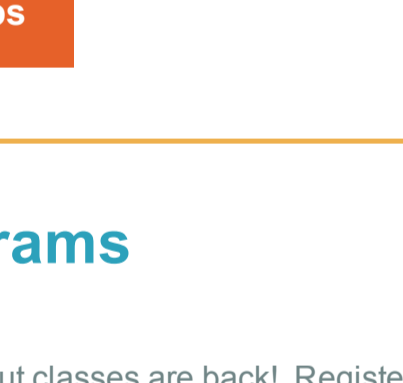

Celebrating the Upcoming Aquatics Season

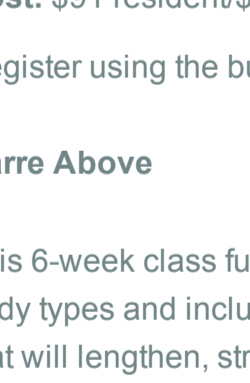

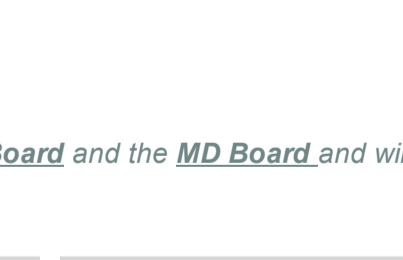

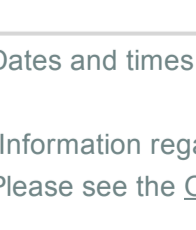
Insurance-Based Fitness Discounts for Seniors at the Pool and Fitness Center

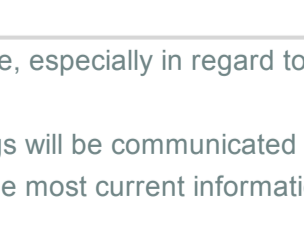

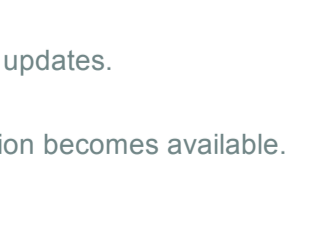
