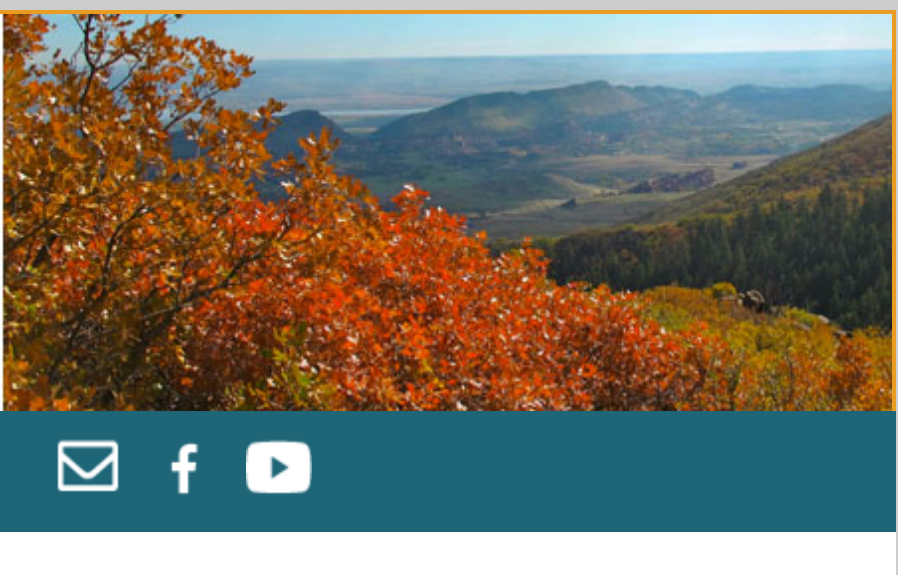

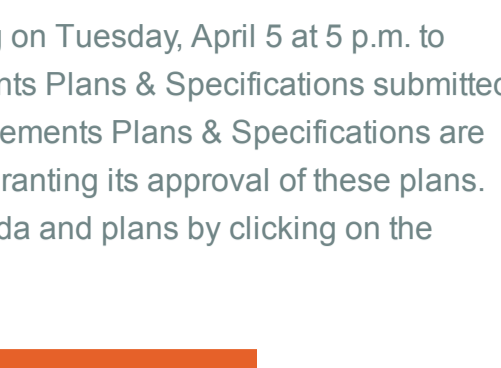

MD Board Special Meeting on NADG Plans & Specs on April 5

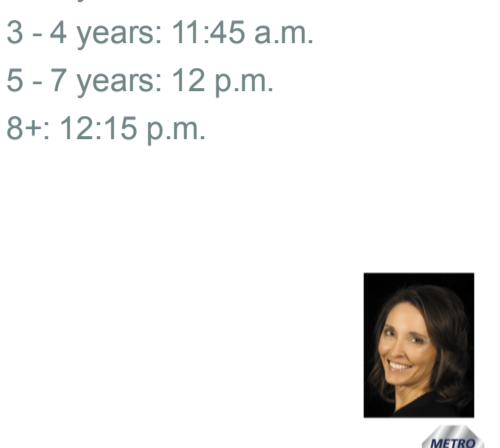

* 5 - 7 years: 12 p.m.

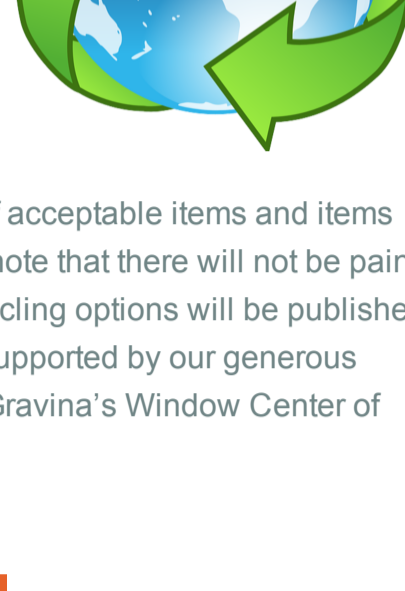

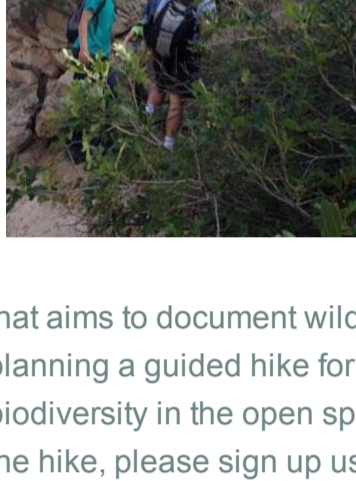

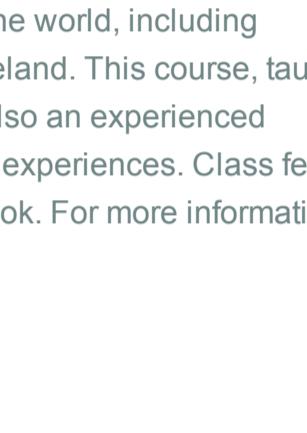
2022 City Nature Challenge Hike

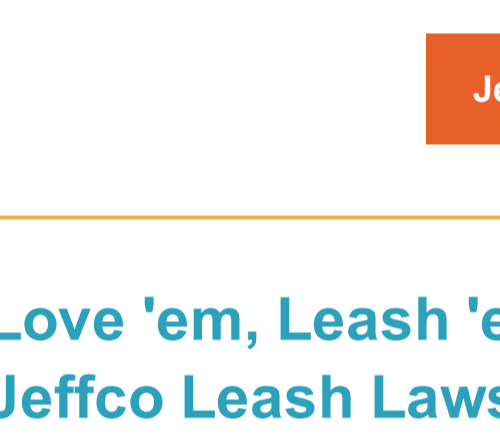

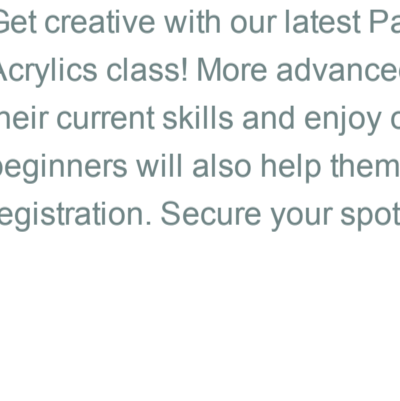

Love 'em, Leash 'em! Jeffco Leash Laws Apply in Ken-Caryl



Regardless of their training or temperament, unleashed dogs may be a danger to other dogs, people and wildlife. Off-leash dogs are also a danger to themselves with running into nearby streets, being hit by cars, being bitten by wildlife or getting lost. Please be considerate of your neighbors and their four-legged friends and please keep your dog on a leash. Residents are reminded that Jeffco leash laws apply to all parts of Ken-Caryl Ranch, including Jeffco School District fields. Rangers who observe leash law violators will be issued a citation. Jeffco can also issue citations and fines up to \$1,000 for unleashed dogs. Unleashed dogs may also be impounded, and owners will be responsible for all applicable impoundment and boarding fees. 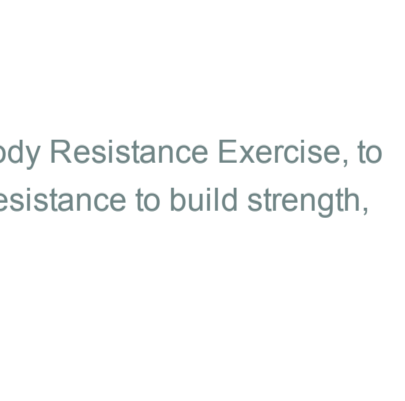

Ken-Caryl Ranch Senior Club Resumes Monthly Meetings

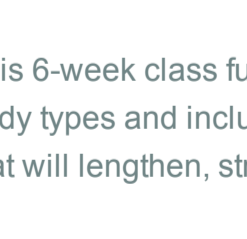

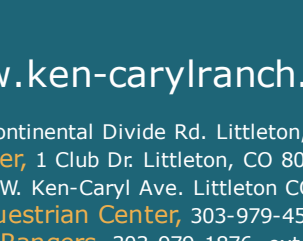
