

This year's election begins April 13 and closes May 3 at 7 p.m. Voting in this election is by MAIL-IN BALLOT ONLY, not online. Ballots will be mailed to eligible

electors of the District from April 11 – April 18. Ballots may be dropped off or mailed to the

locations listed on the ballot. Ballots may be dropped off INSIDE the Ranch House DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS, Monday - Thursday from 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. It is up to the elector to ensure their ballot is received by 7 p.m. on Election Day. currently conducting work in the open space that will continue into the summer and fall. Colorado law requires the management of noxious weeds in our open space. To manage them, the team employs an integrative approach using multiple control methods to combat noxious weed spread. All volunteers must be able to groom and tack up on their own. If interested, please


