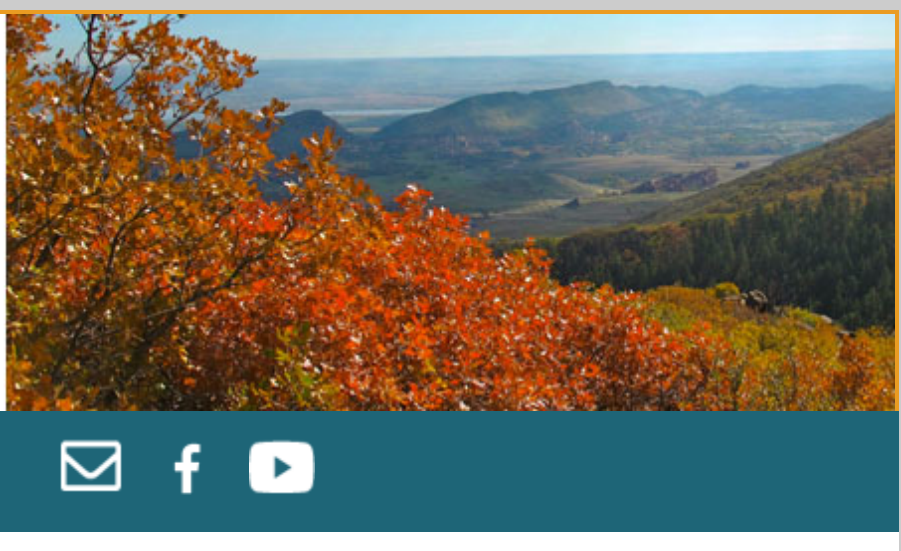




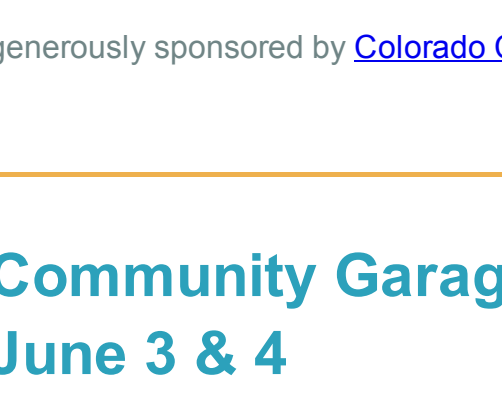

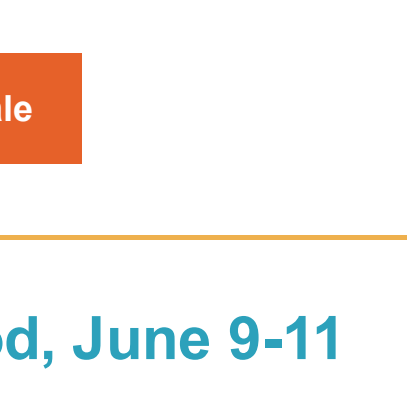
Memorial Day Celebration, May 30

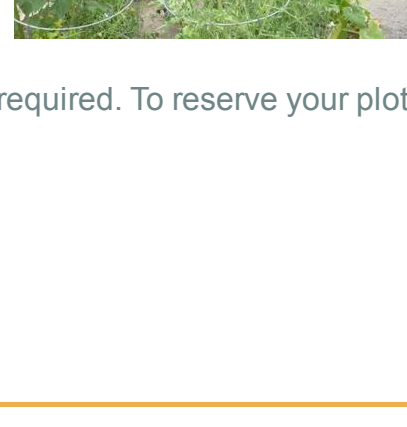
Gone for Good, June 9-11

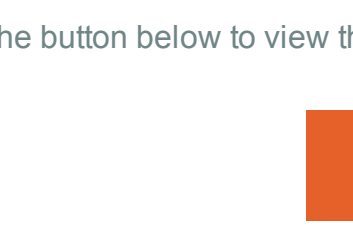

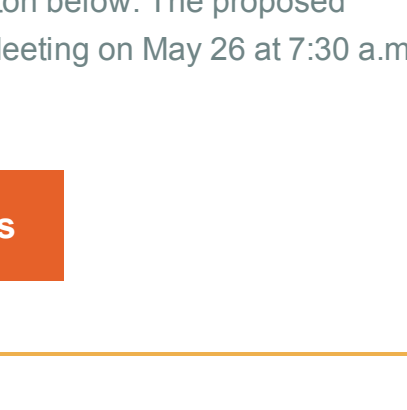
Tennis, Anyone?

Leave Your SLASH at the Curb!

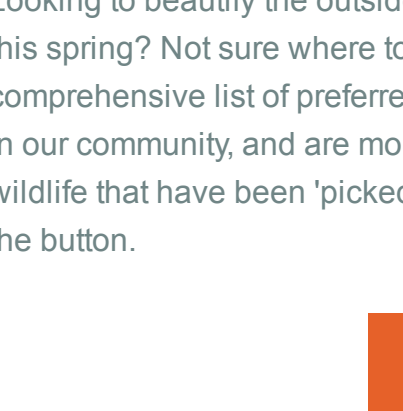
In addition to servicing your trash tote, Waste Connections will also collect up to six bags, or bundles, of yard waste. Branches must be tied and bundled in lengths up to four feet long, one foot in diameter and less than 40 pounds.

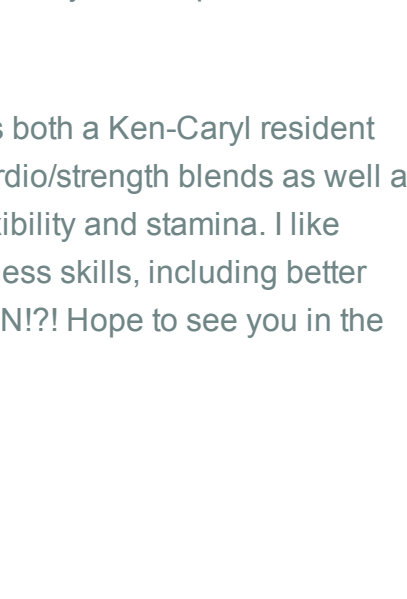

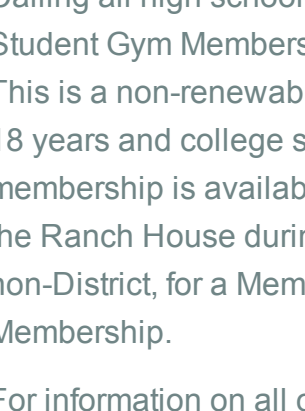

Staff Spotlight: Carla Keahey, Aqua Cardio, Core & Strength Class

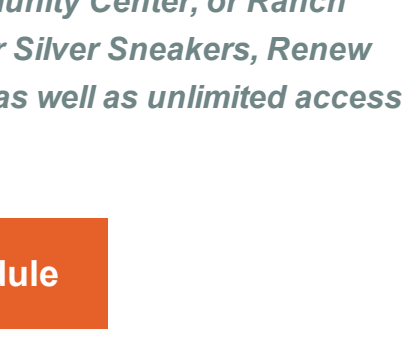
Carla Keahey will teach Aqua Cardio, Core & Strength on Sundays this summer at the Community Center pool from 9-9:50 a.m.

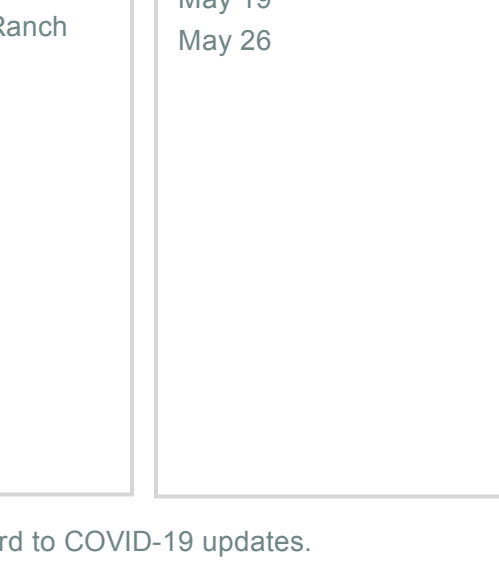
May 31 at 8:45 a.m. The current class schedule is available on the website using the link below and registration opens on Wednesday, May 18.

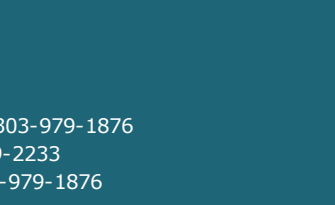
