New LookoutAlert System Replaces CodeRED

LookoutAlert, replacing CodeRED, will quickly notify people within a specific geographic area that may be affected by a large-scale disaster, evacuation or shelter-in-place orders, and other incidents that require immediate public awareness. Individuals who were signed up for CodeRED have been automatically enrolled into LookoutAlert. These residents do NOT need to sign up again but are encouraged to set up an account in the new platform to be able to choose what types of alerts they want to receive and to review and update their information when necessary. All landline residential and commercial phone numbers within the three jurisdictions have also automatically been enrolled into LookoutAlert. 
