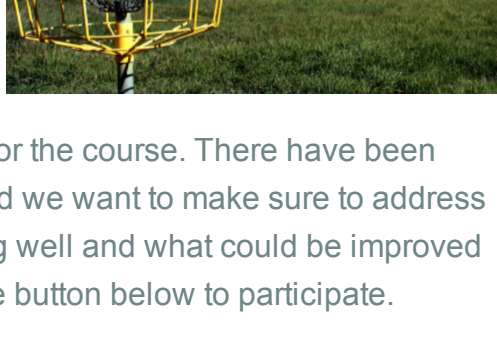

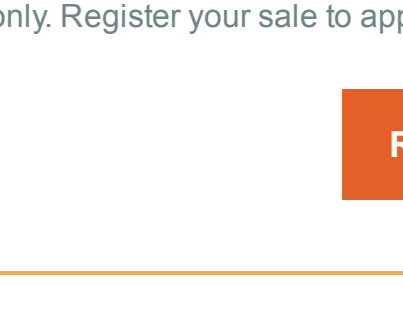

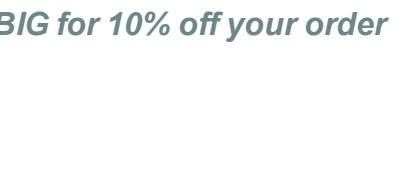


Community Garage Sale, June 3 & 4

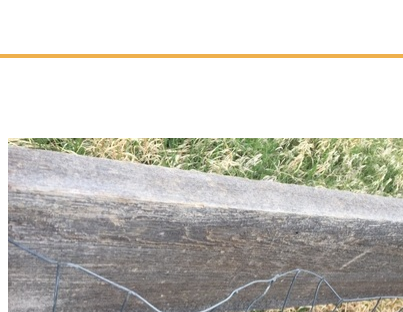
Introducing Tasty Tuesdays: Food Trucks at the Ranch House

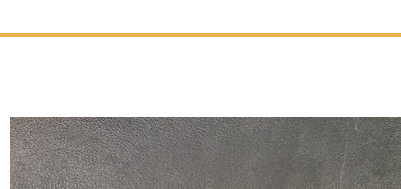

Wednesday Nights at the Manor House Return This Summer!

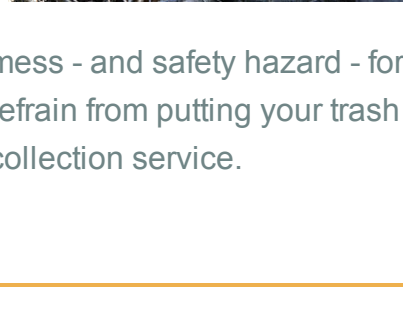

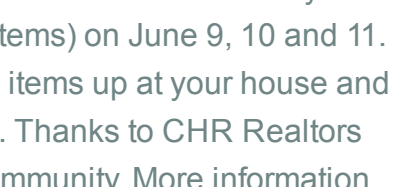
Applications Due June 13 for Fence Task Force

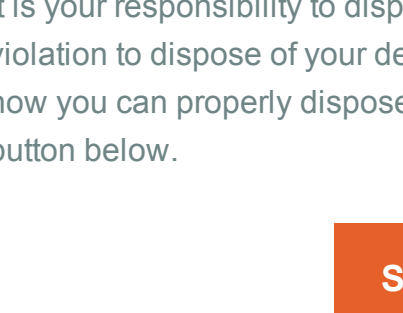

June is Trail Bracelet Awareness Month!



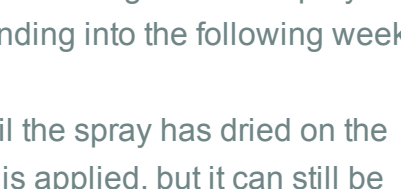

Bear Necessities: Protect Wildlife and Your Neighbors

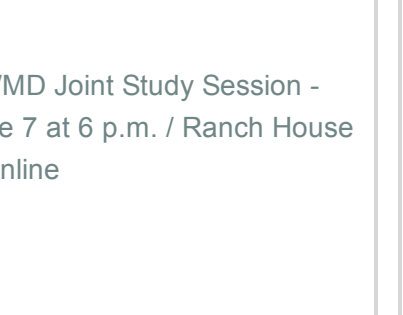

Parks Department Begins Weed Spraying, June 2

The Parks Department will be having the turf grass in all parks and greenbelts sprayed for broadleaf weeds beginning Thursday, June 2, and extending into the following week.

It is recommended that people and pets stay off the turf until the spray has dried on the plant, approximately 10 minutes, or so. A low odor mixture is applied, but it can still be noticed in the air for a bit after spraying. The contractor will be posting with yellow placards at the entrances to the greenbelts and parks where they have sprayed and where they are spraying.

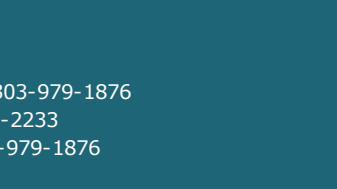
