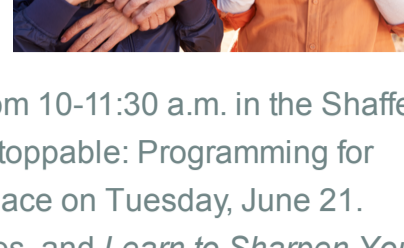

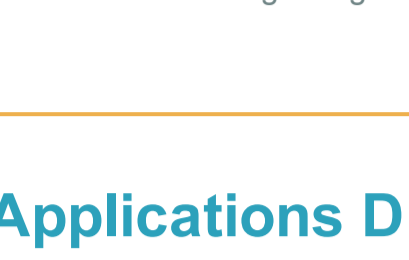

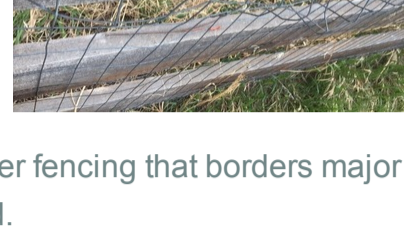

### Track the Weather this Pool Season with the WeatherBug App

Want to track the weather with our lifeguards? Download the WeatherBug app and use the radar to track the storm! The weather changes rapidly; therefore, delays and closures at the pool can happen rapidly as well. Per policy, when thunder is heard or lightning is seen, or within 10 miles, the pool must close until the thunder and/or lightning has stopped for at least 30 min. You will be required to leave the pool and the pool deck for your safety and the safety of our guards. If the pool will be closed for a short amount of time due to weather, we won't post updates on social media. However, if the pool is expected to be closed all day, we will make every effort to update Ken-Caryl Ranch's Facebook page.

### Ranch House Pool Swim Meet Closure, June 11

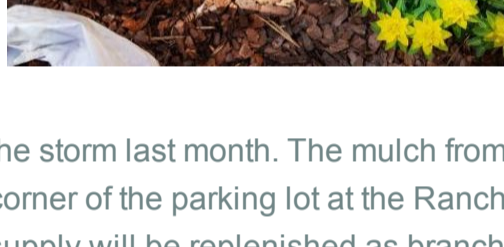


Please note the upcoming Ranch House Pool closure to accommodate the first swim meet of the season:

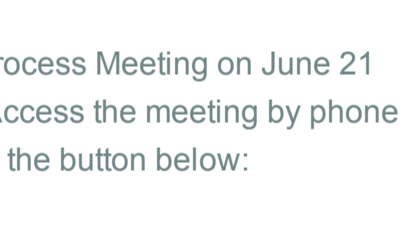


### Free Mulch Available to Residents

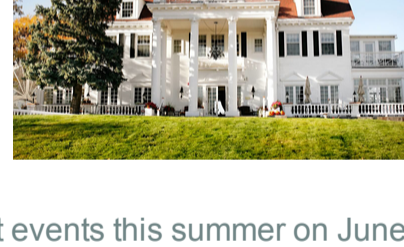
### Tasty Tuesdays: Food Trucks at the Ranch House
