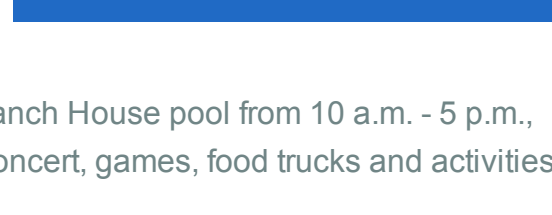

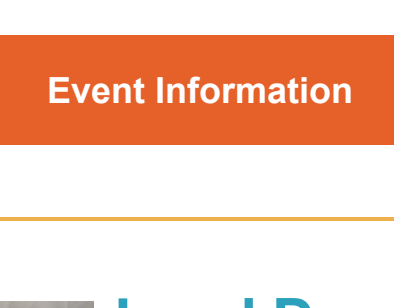
4th of July Bash and Boat Race Registration!



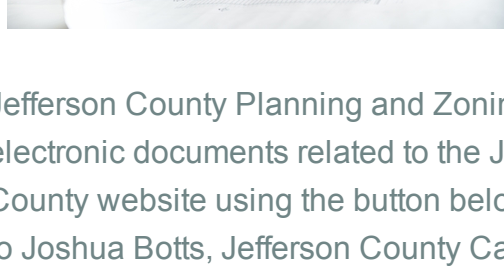

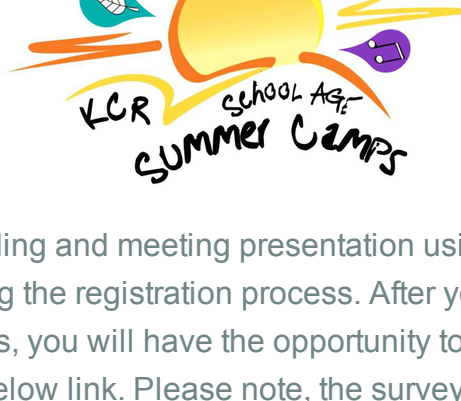


Land Development Update

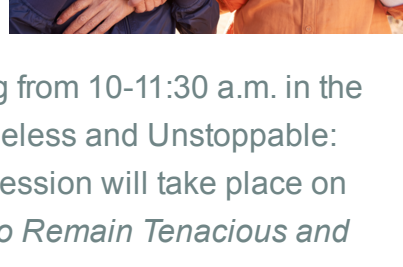


Crime Prevention Presentation

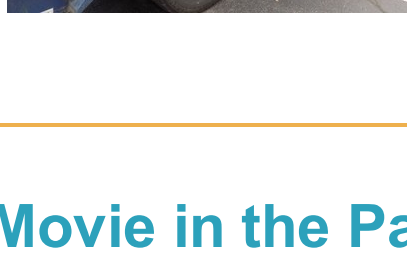

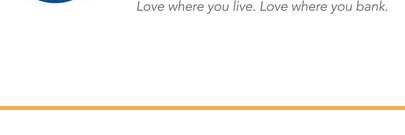


July 4th Holiday Trash Delay

June is Trail Bracelet Awareness Month!

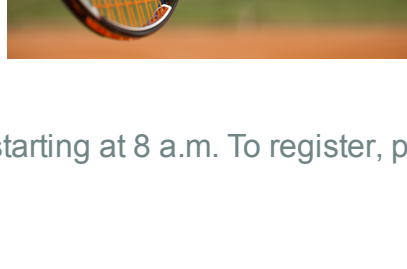

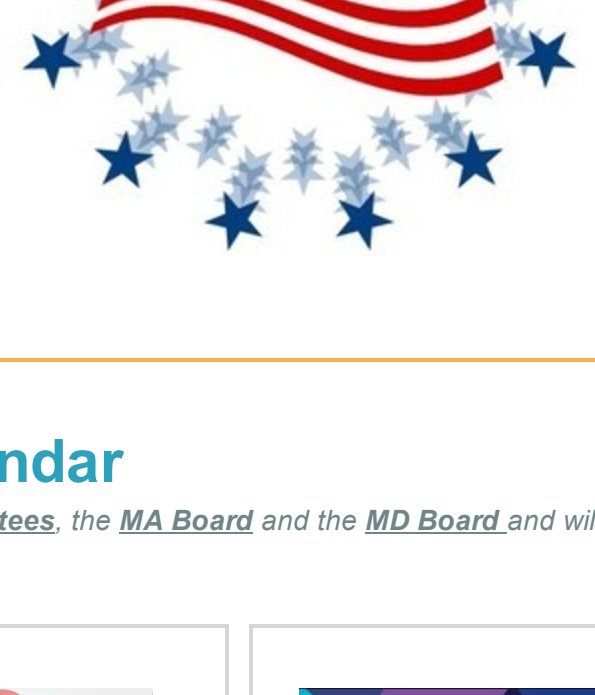
Adult Tennis Lessons
