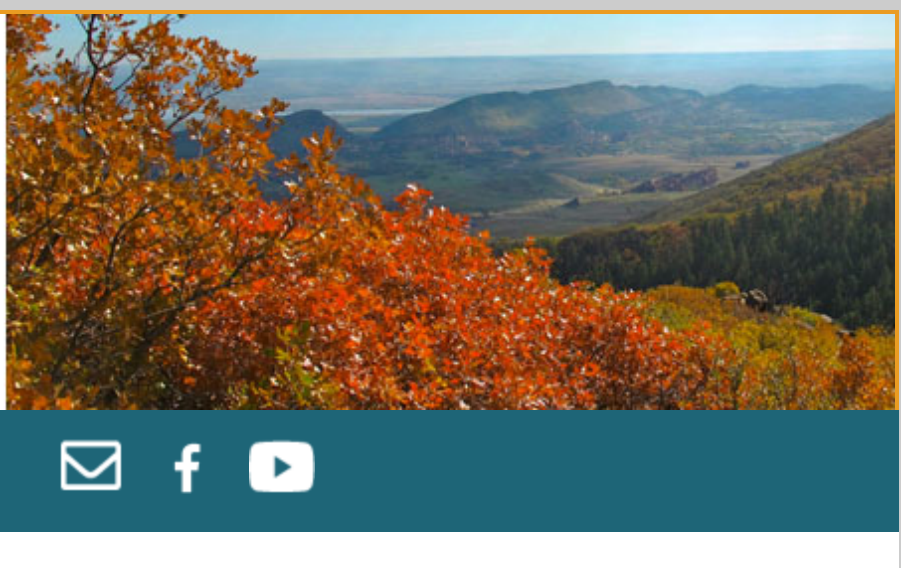

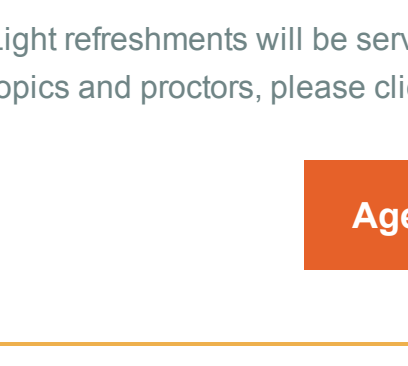
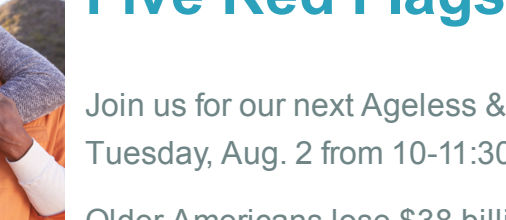

Join us for our next Ageless & Unstoppable series on Tuesday, Aug. 2 from 10-11:30 a.m. at the Ranch House.

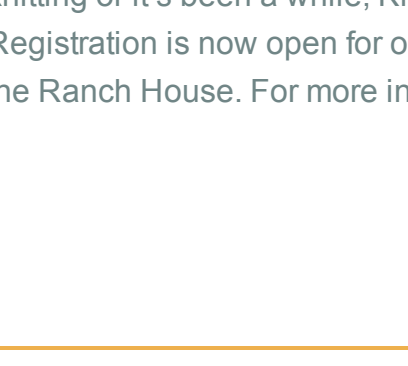

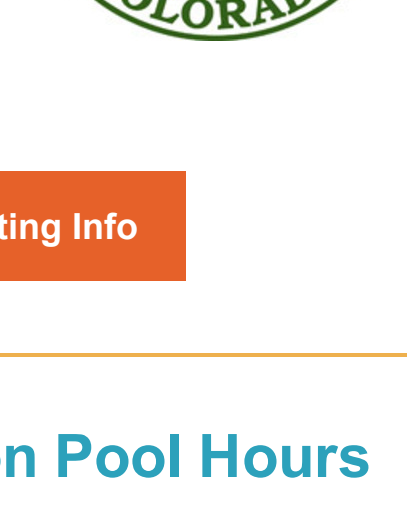
Now Enrolling for Knitting for Everyone!
