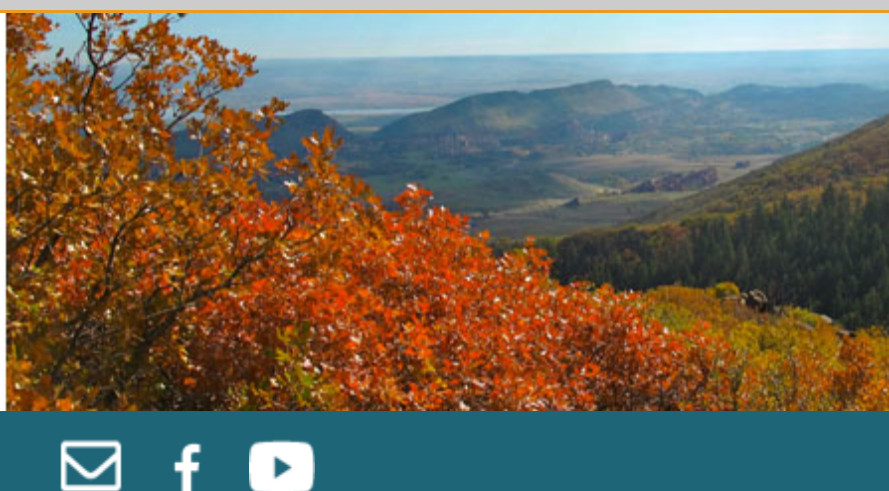

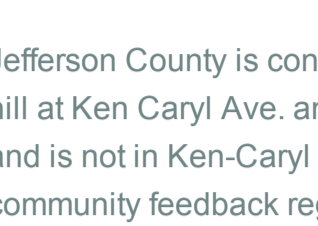
Join us at the Boo Bash!

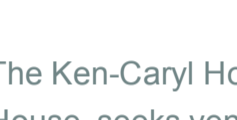
Halloween Horse Fest at the Equestrian Center, Oct. 30

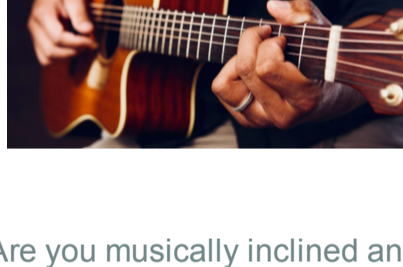

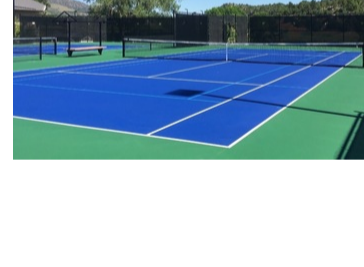


Seeking an Acoustic Musician Volunteer for Veterans Day Event!

Intermediate Disc Golf!

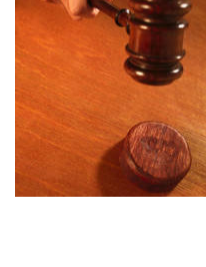

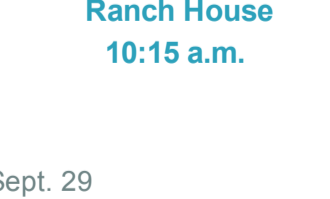
