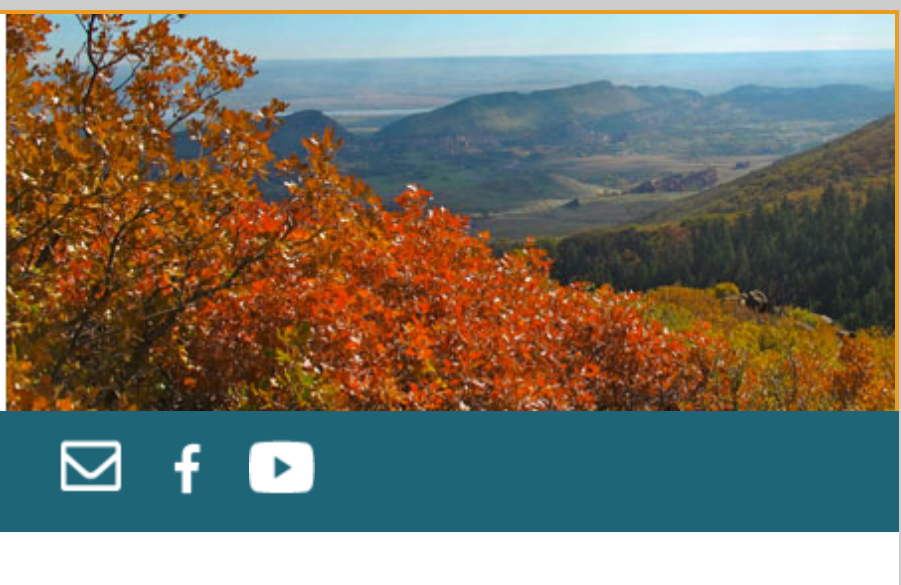

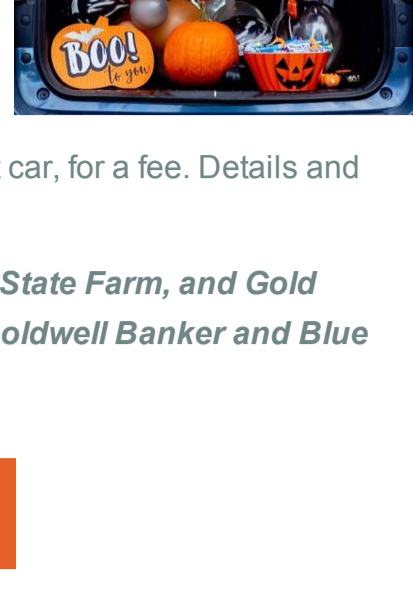

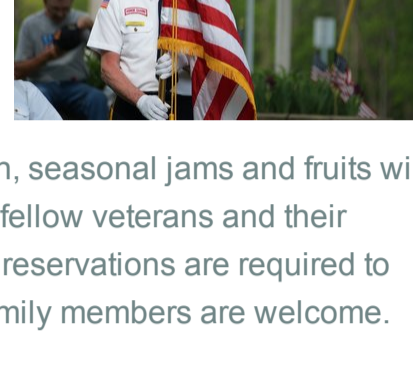

### Veterans Day Breakfast, Nov. 11 at the Ranch House

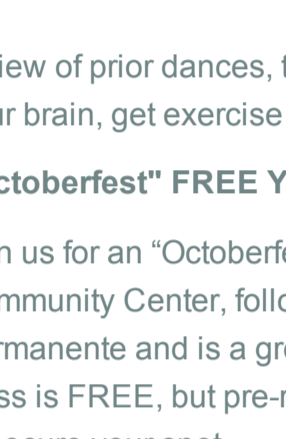
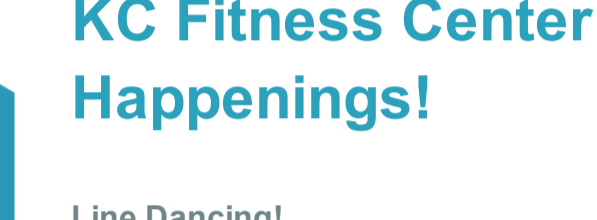

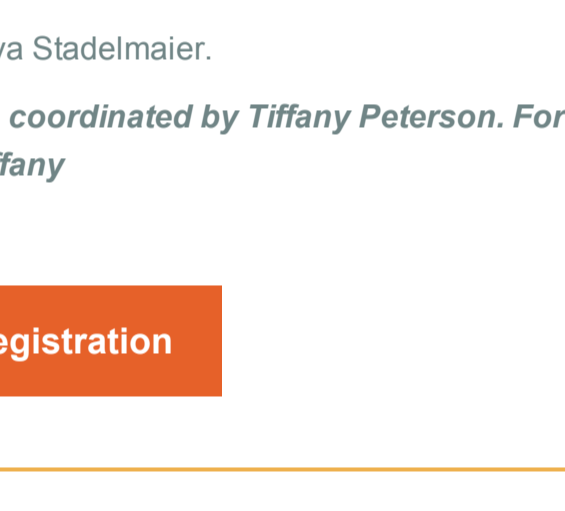
#### "Octoberfest" FREE Yoga Class!

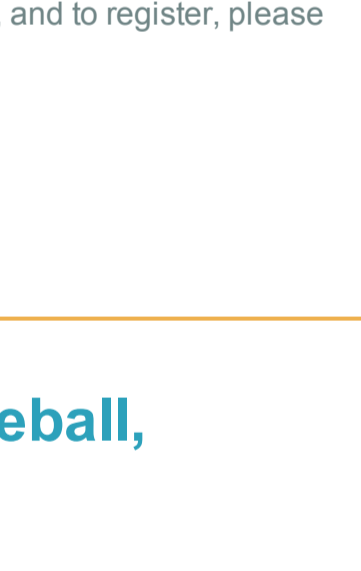
### Good Neighbor/Creatures of the Night Presentation

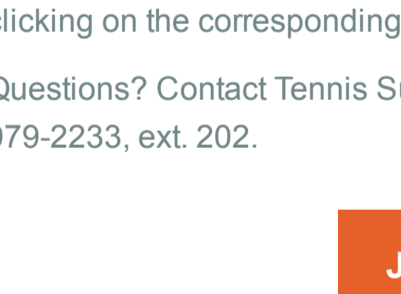
### Fall-Themed Toddler Time

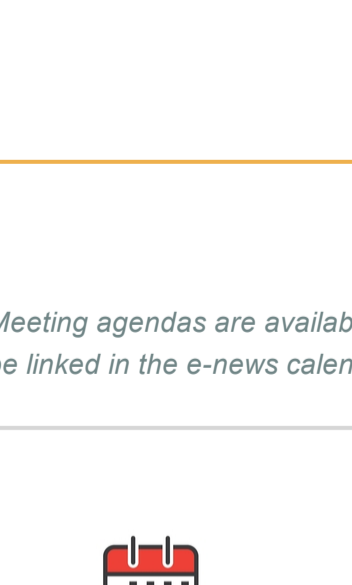
### KCR Historical Society to Participate in International Archaeology Day, Oct. 15

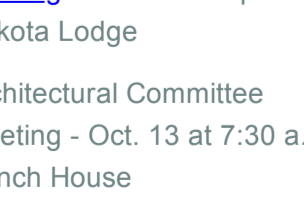

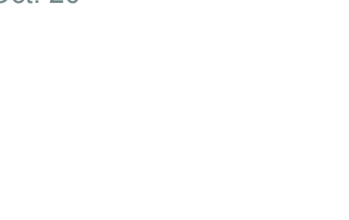
