

your concerns and is planning to install a pedestrian-actuated flashing sign in conjunction with the raised crosswalk at this intersection. Pedestrian-actuated flashing signs, also known as Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB), result in higher motorist compliance for yielding to pedestrians crossing a roadway. County staff supports this approach especially for students crossing Valley Parkway to access Bradford Primary School. \*Jefferson County will host their next informational session to provide project details and answer questions on Oct. 5 at 6 p.m. online via Microsoft Teams. 
