



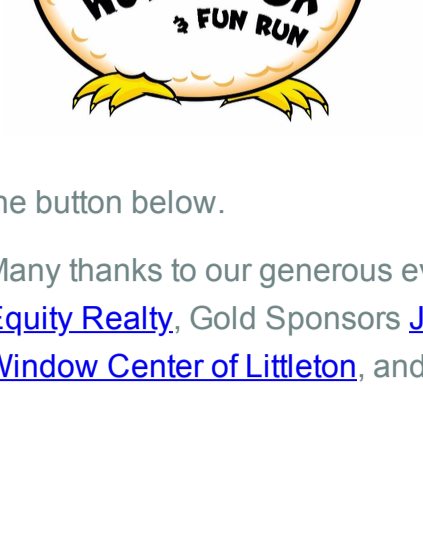

Gobble Wobble 5K & Family Fun Run, Nov. 19

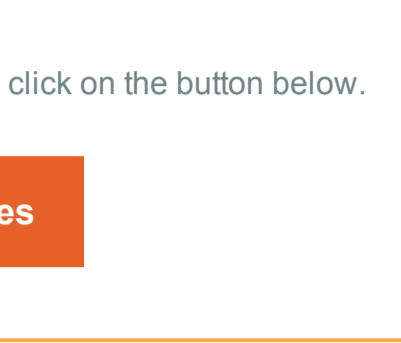

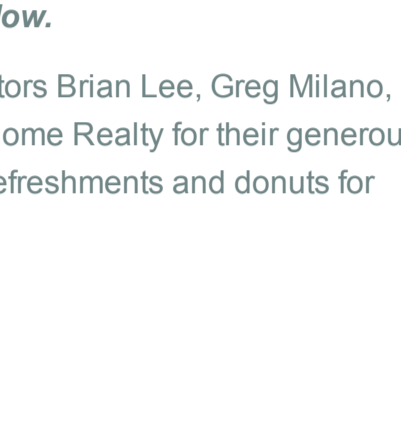

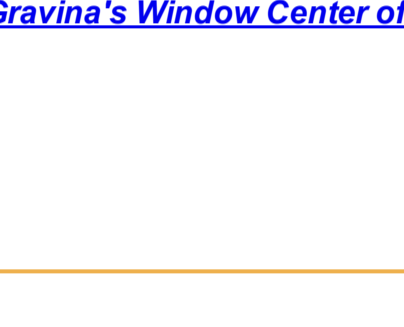
Oh, Christmas Tree - Sale! Reservations Open Tuesday!

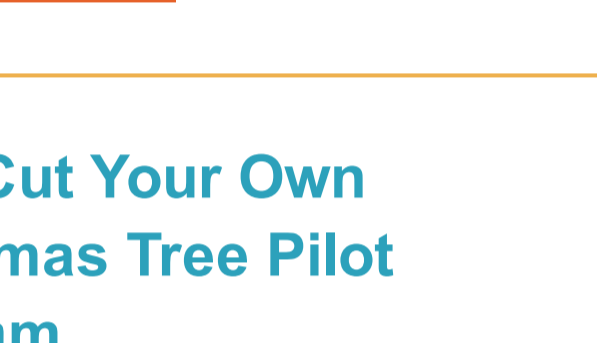
Holiday Happenings at the Ranch House, Dec. 3

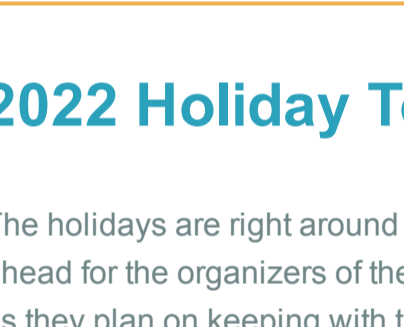

New: Cut Your Own Christmas Tree Pilot Program

New this year, the Ken-Caryl Ranch Master Association has approved a Cut-Your-Own-Christmas Tree Pilot (CYOT) Project in addition to the annual Christmas Tree sale. The pilot project will provide the community with an option to register for a permit, limited to 75 permits, one per family, to hike in the open space and cut a Christmas tree in designated areas. The cost of the permit is \$10, for up to three trees, and all proceeds will go to offsetting Open Space Department expenses. 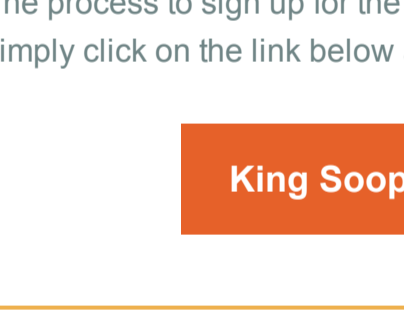

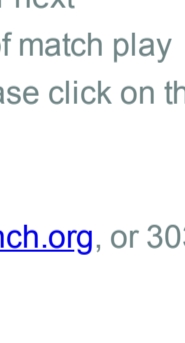


King Soopers Community Rewards Program Benefits KCR!

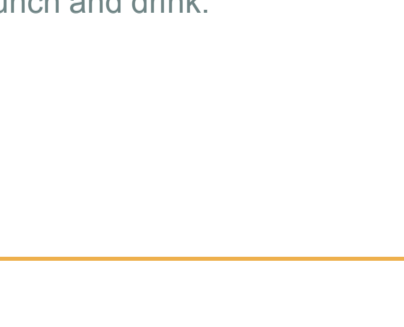
Pickleball Social

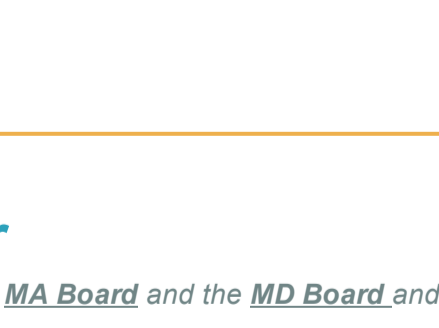


Babysitting Course, Nov. 19

FREE Boomer Fitness Class and Medicare Coverage Q&A Session

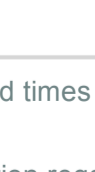

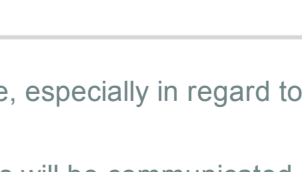
