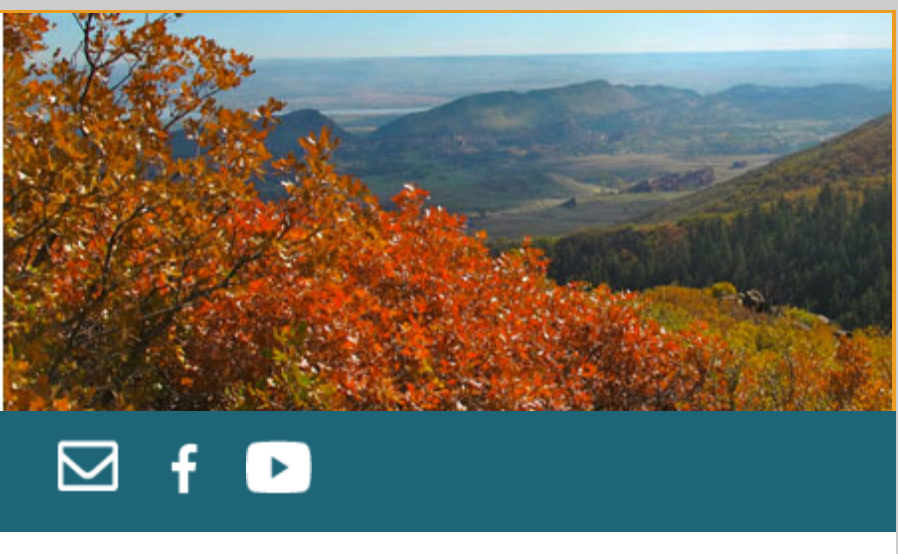

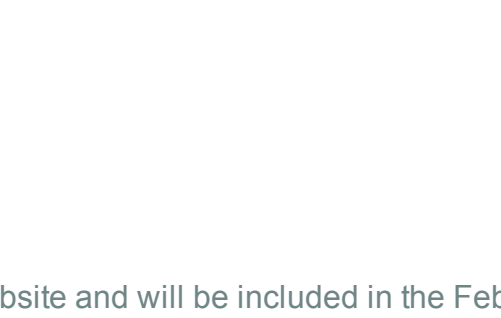

Meet Your 2023 MA Board Candidates

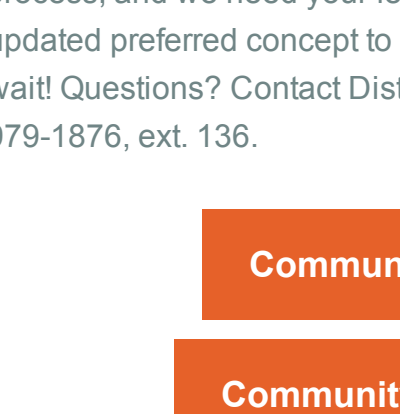
Five residents submitted applications for two open seats on the Master Association Board:

Make Your Voice Heard! Community Park Survey Closes Feb. 10

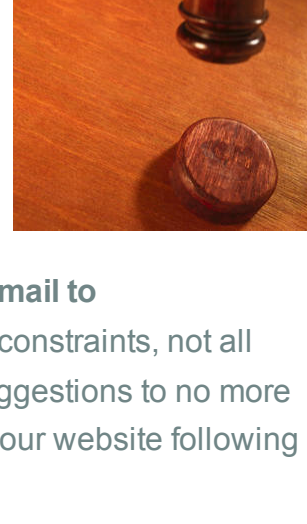

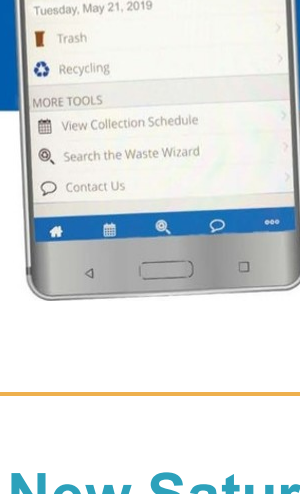

We're now offering two new fitness classes on Saturdays! In addition to our popular Zumba class, we are now offering Spinning and Stretch & Restore!



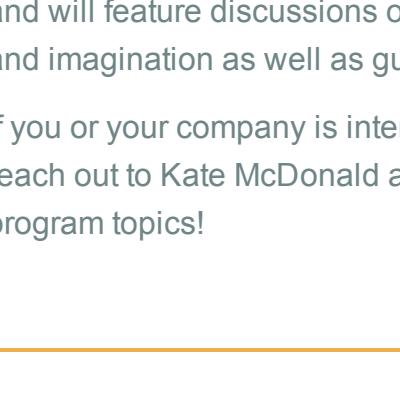
Spinning: 8:15-9 a.m. This class includes hill climbs, sprints and anaerobic intervals for a great cardio workout!

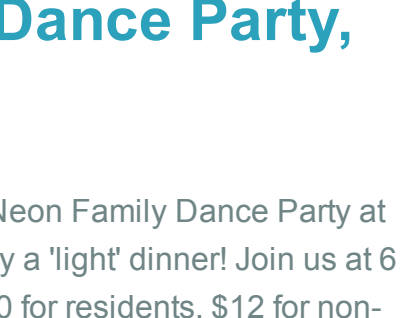


Call for Ageless & Unstoppable Guest Lecturers!

Neon Family Dance Party, Feb. 24

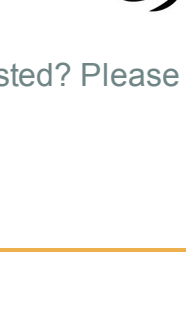

Call for Summer Event Musicians!



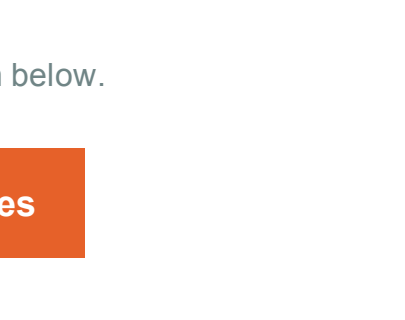

Christmas Holiday Decorations/Lights Reminder

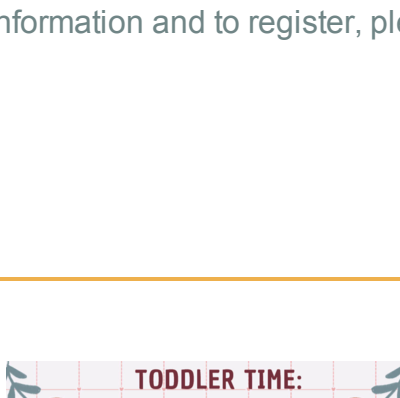
Just a helpful reminder that December holiday lights and decorations need to be turned off, removed and put away by this Wednesday, Feb. 1. This also includes the removal of light clips.

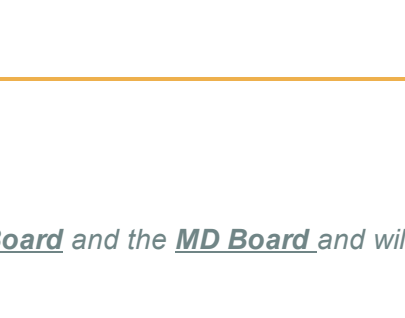
We're Hiring for a Guest Services - Facility Rental Team Member

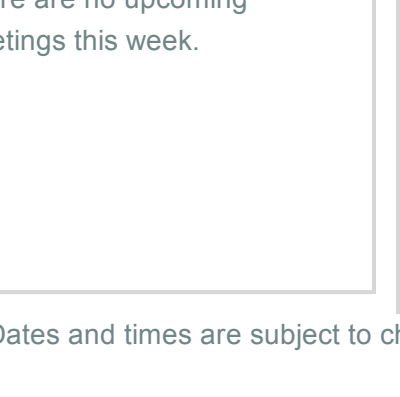

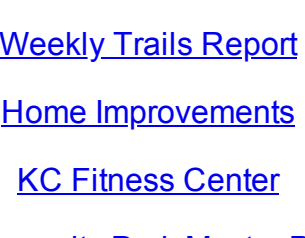
