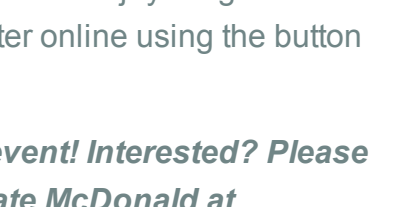
Reminder: Community Park Survey Closes on Friday!

Register for the Family Neon Dance Party, Feb. 24

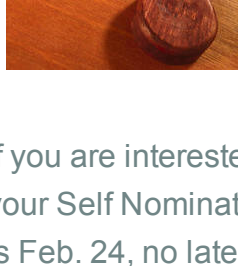

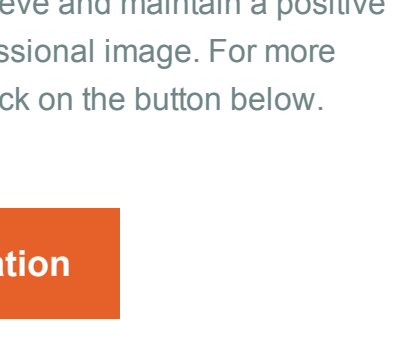
Take a Seat: Calling All 2023 MD Board Candidates!

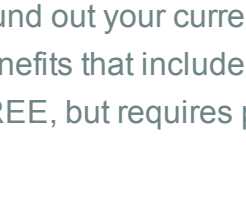

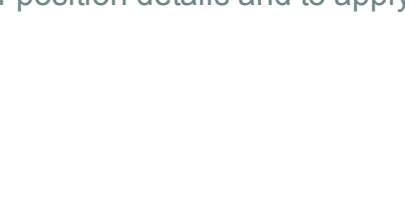


LaBlast Class is Coming this Month!

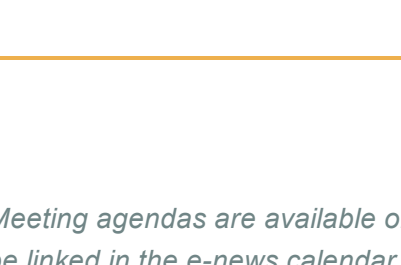
