





This year's Metropolitan District election begins April 10 and closes May 2 at 7 p.m. Ballots will be mailed to eligible electors of the District from April 10 – April 17. Please pay very close attention to the information listed on the secrecy envelope you will receive with your ballot. This includes the locations you can mail or drop off your ballot. If dropping off at the Ranch House, ballots are only accepted INSIDE the Ranch House DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS, Monday – Thursday, 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. It is up to the elector to ensure their ballot is received by 7 p.m. on Election Day. Postmark dates will not be accepted.



SLASHING Fire Risk at Ken-Caryl's SLASH Removal Day on April 22!



Mark your calendars for our next SLASH Removal Day on April 22 from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. at the Dakota Lodge/Equestrian Center. Members of the Metropolitan District Parks Department will be on hand to collect and chip SLASH, which is considered to be tree debris, loose pine needles, pinecones and tree bark that can easily ignite and fuel wildfires. The Master Association Ranger staff will be offering resident SLASH collection and curbside pickup as a courtesy to residents on April 20 and April 21. Residents who wish to participate in curbside collection must sign up prior to the event via our website. 

District Board Exploring Mill Levy Continuance


The Ken-Caryl Ranch Metropolitan District will be retiring the 2014 bond mill levy in December of 2024. The Metropolitan District Board would like your feedback about this opportunity to explore continuance of this mill levy to maintain high-quality park and recreation services without raising taxes. A potential option includes the continuation of an existing mill levy, or a portion of that mill levy. The Board would like input from the community regarding this option. The District's Board could place a ballot initiative on the November 2023 ballot asking voters to approve continuing the full amount or a portion of the amount of the bond requesting mill levy (currently 3.984) as a general operating mill levy. The District wants to hear from you! What are your thoughts on the possible mill levy continuance? Also, do you have a small group that would be interested in engaging in a conversation about this issue?
