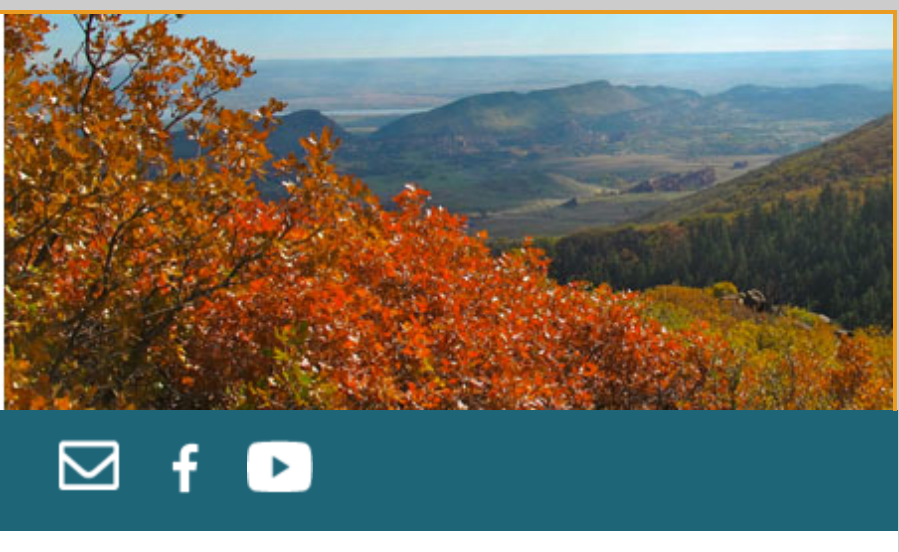




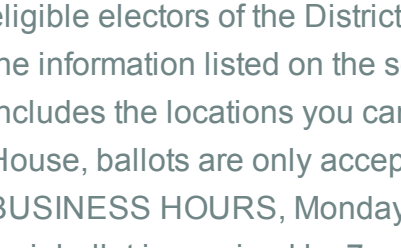

2023 MD Board Election Opens Soon!

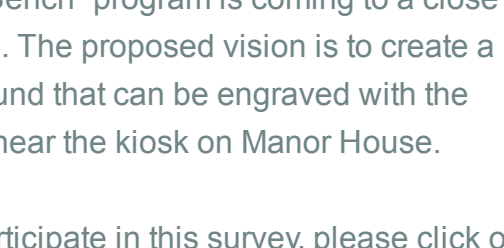
This year's Metropolitan District election begins April 10 and closes May 2 at 7 p.m. Ballots will be mailed to eligible electors of the District from April 10 – April 17. Please pay very close attention to the information listed on the secrecy envelope you will receive with your ballot. This includes the locations you can mail or drop off your ballot. If dropping off at the Ranch House, ballots are only accepted INSIDE the Ranch House DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS, Monday – Thursday, 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. It is up to the elector to ensure their ballot is received by 7 p.m. on Election Day. Postmark dates will not be accepted.

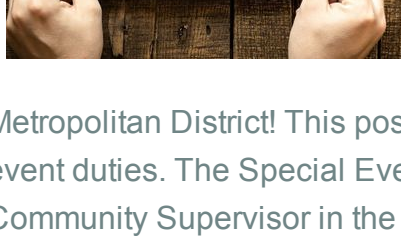
Resident Feedback Survey for Memorials in Ken-Caryl's Open Space

We're Hiring for a Special Events Assistant!

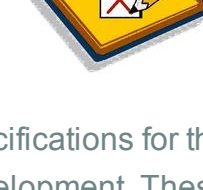

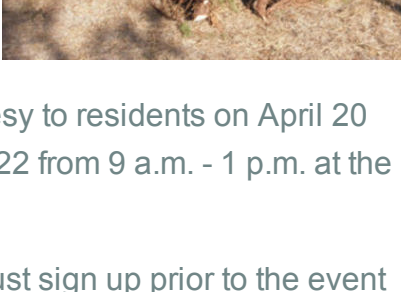


Feedback Requested on Interior Restroom Specs

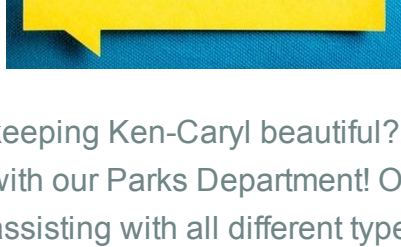

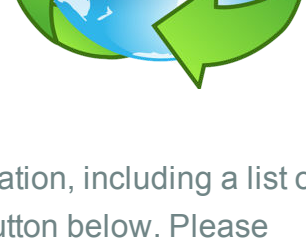


The Parks Department is Hiring for Seasonal Positions!

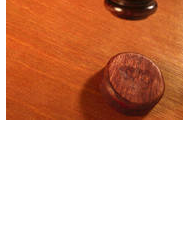
Swim lesson registration is now open for residents and opens on April 10 at 9 a.m. for non-residents. To view classes and to register, please click on the button below.

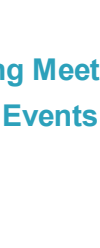
