* If the animal is limping or has a broken leg, but can still move and feed, policy is to let nature take its course per Colorado Parks and Wildlife.

KCRMA PARK RANGERS – 303.979.1876. ext. 170

-Will only euthanize sick/injured deer/elk with a rifle, may call seven days a week (7-530pm) and a ranger will respond depending on location and time available. Seasonals are not certified through CPW to euthanize an animal.

Due to job duties, response time can range from a few minutes to hours
