Jefferson County Property Tax Valuations



You may have seen news headlines this week about the 2023 (payable in 2024) property tax valuations that the

Jefferson County Assessor released this week. Communities across Colorado, including Ken-Caryl Ranch, are seeing 30-50% increases, and some areas are even higher. However, there is impending action from the Colorado legislature that is expected to ease the tax burden on homeowners. We do not have more information at this time on what that legislation will look like or how it will affect homeowners. Property taxes paid to Jefferson County include those taxes that are paid to Ken-Caryl Ranch Metropolitan District, which accounts for approximately 18% of the total paid to the County. Given this, the Metropolitan District is anxiously awaiting the rollout of this legislative action so we can more accurately provide financial forecasting to the Board and the community and determine any possible next steps.

Brannon Gearhart Pond Drainage Improvement Project



Work to begin dredging the Brannon Gearhart Park of excess sediment is slated to begin mid-May. This project

aims to improve the depth of the pond to deter algae growth in the summer and ready the pond for potential storm threats in the future. The accumulation of excess sediment can result in stagnant water that raises the internal temperature of the pond and increases the likelihood of algae growth. The work is scheduled to begin this month, weather permitting, and is expected to be completed within a few weeks. Community Garage Sale June 2-3


