## BE ADVISED: AGGRESSIVE DEER

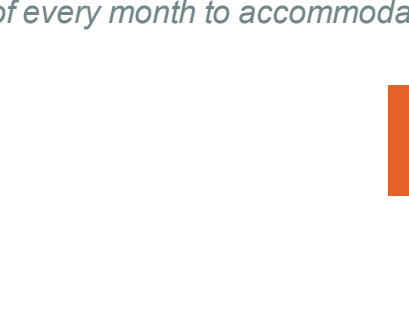
DEER CAN BE AGGRESSIVE PROTECTING FAWNS THIS TIME OF YEAR — ESPECIALLY AROUND DOGS —

- Keep dogs on short leashes and put distance between yourselves and wildlife
- Carry a walking stick; swing it or hit the ground with it to make noise
- Use a noise-maker to scare away wildlife
- Clap hands, throw small items in the area to scare wildlife

### Ageless & Unstoppable: Healthy Living for Your Brain & Body on June 20



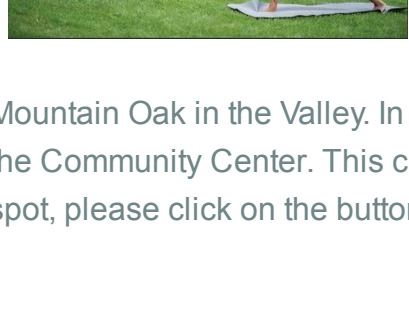

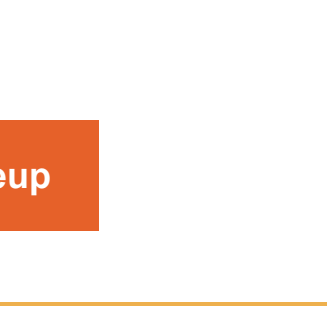
### FREE Yoga in the Park on June 21

### Join us for Tasty Tuesday!

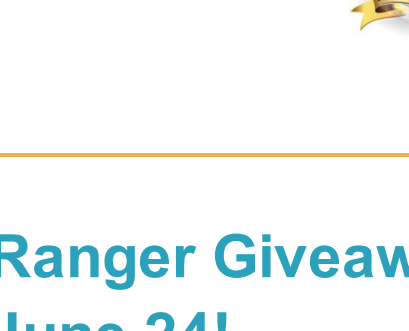

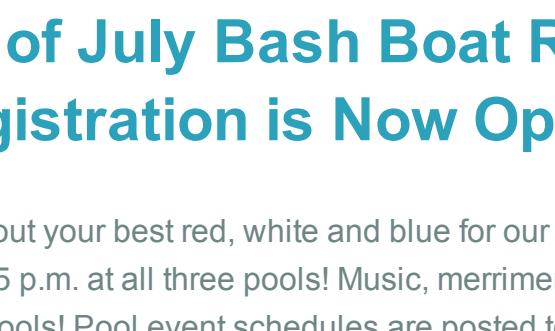


### Movie in the Park on June 24!

Stay tuned! Additional Giveaway Days are scheduled in July, August and September.

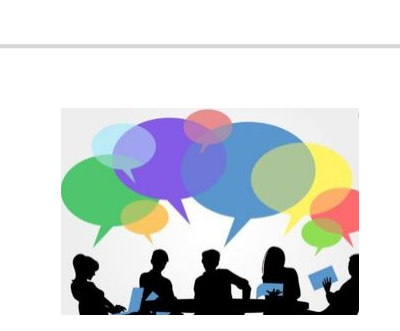


### 4th of July Bash Boat Race Registration is Now Open!

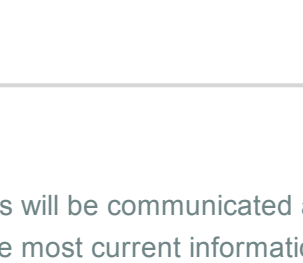

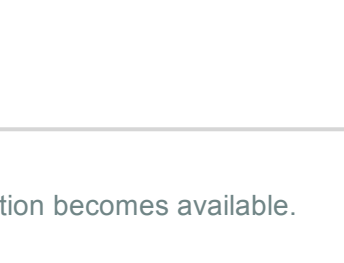
