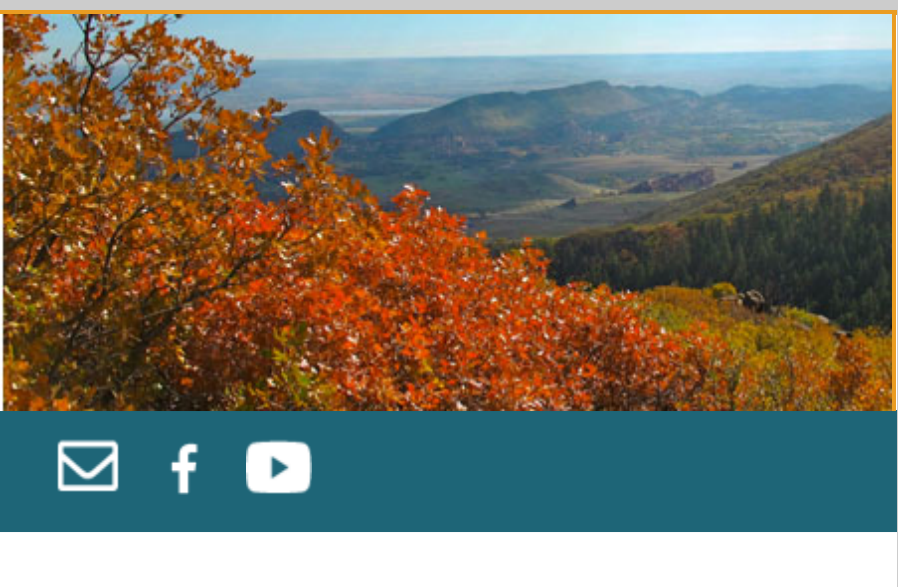




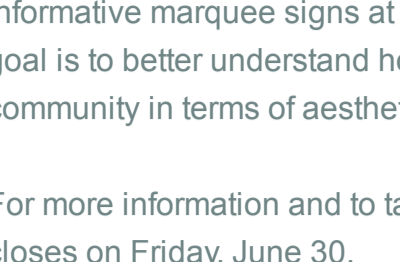

## Have you Participated in Our Community Signage Survey?

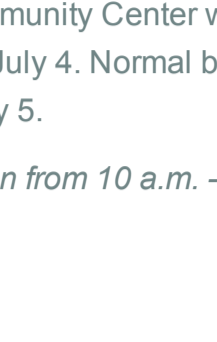

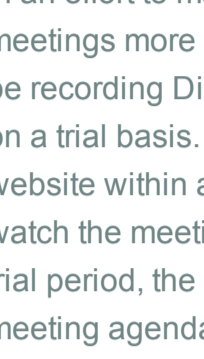

## Tennis Block Time Application (Formerly PCT)

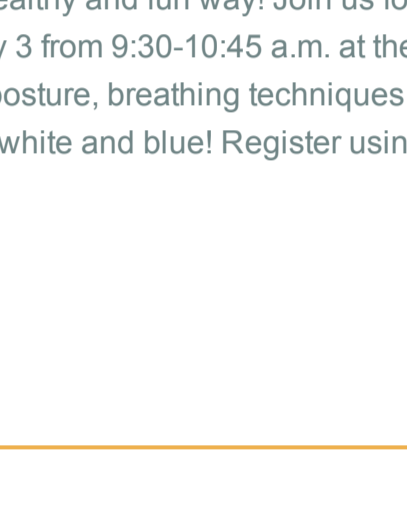
The online application period for Fall Indoor Tennis Block Time, formerly known as PCT (Permanent Court Time) is now open through Friday, July 30 for resident captains.

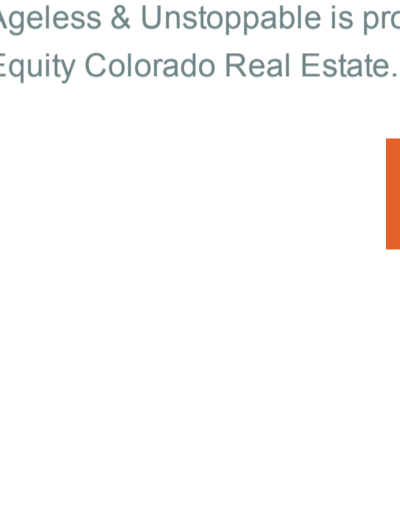
## Tennis - Junior - Summer Session 2

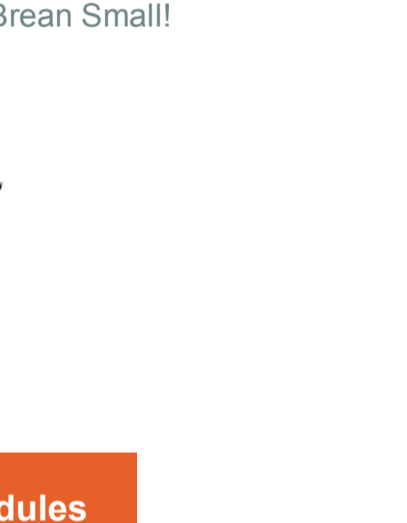
## Red, White and You Hatha Yoga on July 3!

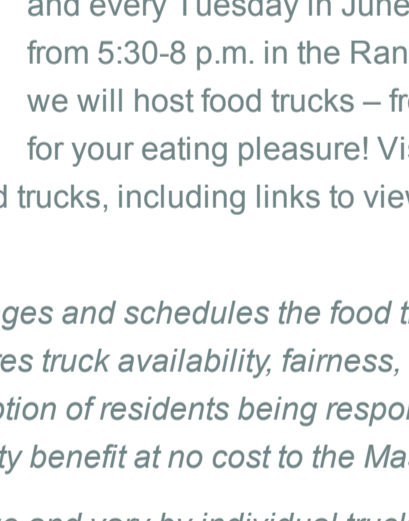

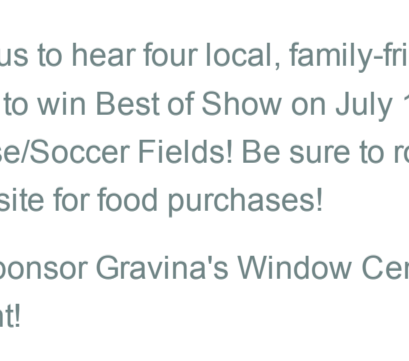


## 4th of July Bash at All 3 Pools!

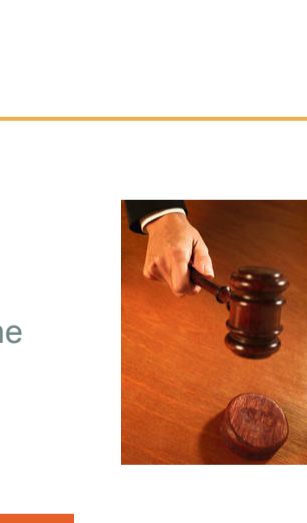

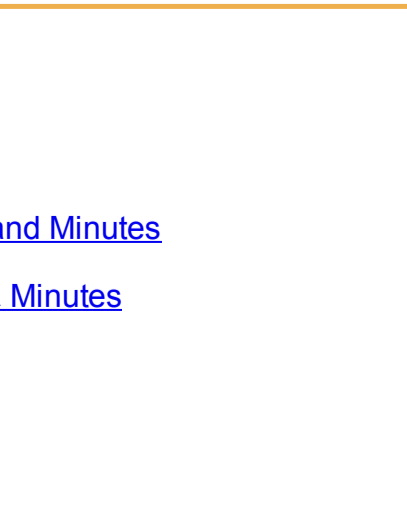

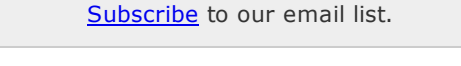
