



The Metropolitan District spends the bulk of the fall months developing the budget for the following year. The draft budget will be presented to

\*If Proposition HH fails, the MD Board meeting may be held on Tuesday, Dec. 12, if the Board determines it is necessary to have further discussion on one or more budget topics before approving the 2024 Budget.

\*If Proposition HH passes, the MD Board meeting will be held on Wednesday, Jan. 3, 2024. This will be a Public Hearing.
