District Board Budget Update

The Ken-Caryl Ranch Metropolitan District will hold a special Board meeting on Monday, Jan. 8 at 6 p.m. at the Ranch House. The purpose of the meeting is to approve the budget and certify the mill levy. The 2024 Draft Budget will be posted to our website at www.ken-carylranch.org by the end of the week.

The budget adoption is delayed this year due to a state legislature special session in response to the defeat of Proposition HH. The state legislature subsequently approved Senate Bill 23B-001, which decreases the residential assessment rate from 6.765% to 6.7% and increases the residential property exempt amount from \$15,000 to \$55,000. Residents are encouraged to review the budget and provide feedback to the Board by emailing mdboard@kcranch.org or attend the special meeting on Jan. 8.
