The 2024 MA Board Election is in Full Swing!

Virtually meet your 2024 MA Board candidates! Five residents submitted applications for two open



seats on the Master Association Board. You can view their candidate profiles online by clicking on the button below.

The Ken-Caryl Ranch Master Association Board is underway and runs through March 5 at 5 p.m. Here's how the election works:

* Residents and businesses with an email address in our accounting system should have received an email from kcr@ivotehoa.com with voting instructions.

- * Those residents and businesses without an email in the system should have received a postcard in the mail.
- * There is one ballot per household, or business. If you own multiple properties, or are a business, you will vote only once, but your vote will be weighted according to how many properties you own, or acreage of business.
- * The election will be done online, but paper ballots will be available at the Ranch House Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., or by appointment, for those residents who do not wish to vote online. To make an appointment, please email MA General Manager Brian Yowell at briany@kcranch.org. You will need a photo ID to vote with a paper ballot. *Please note the Ranch House is closed to the public on Fridays.

Master Association Annual Meeting is March 5

Order Your Recycling Totes Online

Waste Connections Inc. Per our current contract with Waste Connections, recycling pick-ups will continue on a weekly basis until

Ken-Caryl officially transitions to bi-weekly recycling collection services on May 1, 2024. Once the new contract goes into effect, only recycling in approved Waste Connections totes will be collected. To accommodate resident preferences and needs, residents may request recycling totes in pre-approved 64-gallon or 96-gallon sizes using the online form linked below. Residents may also request additional recycling totes using this form for an additional \$6 monthly fee that will be billed to you directly by Waste Connections.

The delivery of the new recycling totes will be prioritized prior to the start of bi-weekly recycling collection services on May 1; however, residents may also request new trash collection totes in either 64-gallon or 96-gallon sizes via this form that will be kept on file and delivered at a later date. Residents will receive delivery information once it becomes available.

The deadline to order containers is Friday, March 15.

Please note: If you have a Waste Connections tote with an orange lid, you are not required to place an order to replace your tote. Waste Connections will take your small bins once they drop off your new totes, just mark it with "Trash, please take." Due to room, it may take a few trips to collect all of these bins, so please be patient. They will be collected at no charge. Have a tote from another trash provider? Waste Connections stickers will be available at the Ranch House and the Community Center for pick-up beginning Feb. 27 to cover your previous provider's logo. Residents are also encouraged to bring any old bins to Ken-Caryl's Annual Recycling & Clean-Up event at the Ranch House on May 4. Stay tuned - event details to come!


