Transition to Bi-Weekly Recycling Collection:

- Recycling pick-ups will continue weekly until May 1.
- Starting May 1, bi-weekly recycling collection services will commence.
- Only approved Waste Connections totes will be collected under the new contract.

Request Recycling Totes Online:

- Residents can request recycling totes in 64-gallon or 96-gallon sizes via our online form, accessible by clicking on the button below.
- Additional recycling totes can be requested for a \$6 monthly fee billed directly by Waste Connections.

Delivery Prioritization:

- New recycling totes will be prioritized for delivery before May 1.
- Residents can also request new trash collection totes for future delivery.

Order Deadline:

- Deadline for ordering containers is Friday, March 15.

Special Instructions for Waste Connections Totes:

- Residents with Waste Connections totes with orange lids need not order replacements.
- Waste Connections will collect small bins; mark them with "Trash, please take."

Handling Totes from Other Providers:

- Waste Connections stickers will be available for pick-up to cover logos of previous trash providers on Feb. 27 at the Ranch House and the Community Center.
- Residents are encouraged to bring old bins to Ken-Caryl's Annual Recycling & Clean-

Up event on May 4.

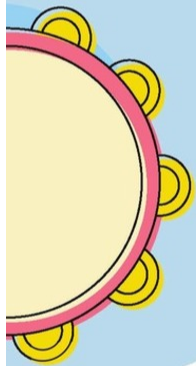

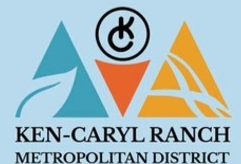

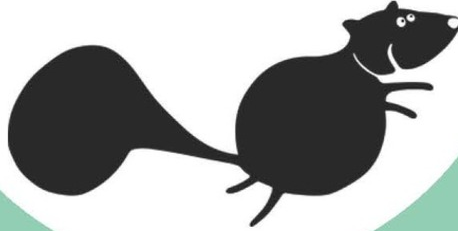
