Spring SLASH Drop-off Event and Curbside Pick-Ups



Ken-Caryl's next SLASH Drop-off Event is on April 27 from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. at the Equestrian Center/Dakota Lodge. SLASH is debris from nature, such as tree limbs and prunings that can serve as fuel for wildfire. No reservations necessary, residents may drop off SLASH at any time during the event. The Ken-Caryl Ranch Metropolitan District Parks Department will be on hand with the chipper.

A limited number of curbside pickups will be offered by the Master Association Ranger staff on Wednesday, April 24 and Thursday, April 25 for residents who are unable to drop-off their own SLASH. ***SLASH curbside pick-up registration must be made in advance and opens on our website via the Firewise Resources page, located under the Resident Resources tab, on March 25. Only one sign-up per household, please.*** Stay tuned - sign-up and more information to come!

No need to register if you can drop off your own SLASH. Just stop by any time during the event on April 27.

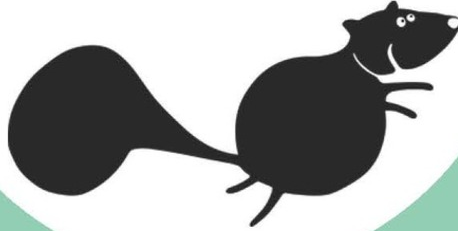
