Spring SLASH Drop-off Event and Curbside Pick-Ups



Ken-Caryl's next SLASH Drop-off Event is on April 27 from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. at the Equestrian Center/Dakota Lodge. SLASH is debris from nature, such as tree limbs and prunings that can serve as fuel for wildfire. No reservations necessary, residents may drop off SLASH at any time during the event. The Ken-Caryl Ranch Metropolitan District Parks Department will be on hand with the chipper.

A limited number of curbside pickups will be offered by the Master Association Ranger staff on Wednesday, April 24 and Thursday, April 25 for residents who are unable to drop-off their own SLASH. **SLASH curbside pick-up registration must be made in advance and opens on our website via the Firewise Resources page, located**

under the Resident Resources tab, on March 25. Only one sign-up per household, please. Stay tuned - sign-up link to come next week!

No need to register if you can drop off your own SLASH. Just stop by any time during the event on April 27.

Pool Pass Registration Now Open

Resident pool pass registration is now open for the 2024 season. As a reminder, all residents looking to access the pool for free MUST register online at the link below



before visiting the pools. No need to get a new pool key fob if you have yours from last year; just register online and the old fob will work! Please stop by the Ranch House or Community Center during business hours if you would like a fob. Pool staff can't issue fobs.

For entry into the pool you may use the following:

- * An activated fob (if you had a fob for your pool pass in 2023, when you register this year it will automatically update)
- * A photo of your activated fob
- * A photo of the barcode on your receipt when you register for a pool pass

If you don't have any of these but did register, staff can check you in by searching your name. This is less ideal as it takes time when other patrons are waiting to check in.

Our pools will be adopting a cashless payment policy this summer. All non-residents visiting the pools are encouraged to purchase their passes online before arriving at the pools. In-person payment methods accepted are credit or debit card, Apple Pay and Google Pay.

Wednesdays, April 3 - 24 9:15 - 10 a.m. Community Center Register to secure a spot!




This 4-week creative movement dance class provides young children with an introduction to the magical world of dance!
